Materials

- Cotton ricorumi
- Crochet hook: 2,5 mm
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- Safety eyes (8 mm)
- Stitch marker
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- RND: round
- MR: magic ring
- Ch : chain
- Sl st: slip stitch
- Sc: single crochet
- Inc: increase
- Dec: decrease
- () *: repeat till the end of round
- []: total number of stitches in the round

Head

In white

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: 6 x inc [12]

RND 3: (1 sc, inc)* [18]

RND 4: (2 sc, inc)* [24]

RND 5: (3 sc, inc)* [30]

RND 6: (4 sc, inc)* [36]

RND 7: (5 sc, inc)* [42]

RND 8: (6 sc, inc)* [48]

RND 9- 14: 48 sc [48]

RND 15: (6 sc, dec)* [42]

RND 16: (5 sc, dec)* [36]

RND 17: (4 sc, dec)* [30]

RND 18: (3 sc, dec)* [24]

RND 19: (2 sc, dec)* [18]

Insert the eyes and stuff.

Fasten off and leave a long tail to attach the body (tutorial). Stuff firmly the neck before closing.

Body

Start in white

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: 6 x inc [12]

RND 3: (1 sc, inc)* [18]

RND 4: (2 sc, inc)* [24]

RND 5: (3 sc, inc)* [30]

RND 6: (4 sc, inc)* [36]

RND 7-10 : 36 sc [36]

RND 11: (4 sc, dec)* [30]

RND 12: 30 sc [30] Change to black:

RND 13: (3 sc, dec)* [24]

RND 14: 24 sc [24]

RND 15: (2 sc, dec)* [18]

RND 16: 18 sc [18]

Change to white:

RND 17: 18 sc [18]

Stuff and fasten off.

Ears (x2)

In black

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: inc x 6 [12]

RND 3: (3 sc, inc)* [15]

RND 4-6: 15 sc [15]

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing to head.

Eyes (x2)

In black

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: inc x 6 [12]

RND 3: (3 sc, inc)* [15]

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Insert the security eyes in the center of the eye patch. Insert to the head btw RND 10 and 11.

Nose

In white

Ch 6 (start in second ch from hook)

RND 1: 4 SC, 3 sc in last st, 3 sc, inc [12]

RND 2: (inc, 3 sc)* [15]

For a longer nose, add a RND 3 making 15 sc.

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Tail

In white

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: (1 sc, inc)* [9]

RND 3: 9 sc [9]

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Legs (x2)

In black

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: inc x 6 [12]

RND 3: (1 sc, inc)* [18]

RND 4: back loop - 18 sc [18]

RND 5-6: 18 sc [18]

RND 7: (1 sc, dec)* [12]

RND 8: (2 sc, dec)* [9]

RND 9-12: 9 sc [9]

RND 13: (1 sc, dec)* [6]

Close. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

Bring out the thread to the inside of the leg and sew to body.

Arms (x2)

In black

RND 1: MR + 6 sc [6]

RND 2: (1 sc, inc)* [9]

RND 3-7: 9 sc [9]

RND 8: (1 sc, dec)* [6]

Stuff.

Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.
