Materials

- LaVita yarn velur – one skein of the main color and a little extra. You can use any analogue of Plush yarn, where in 100 g / 120 m.
- YarnArt jeans black for muzzle and nose decoration
- Filler
- Eyes 12 mm
- Hook No4 for knitting a toy, No2 for knitting a spout
- Sewing pins
- Scissors
- Needle for sewing details and embroidery of the face
- Thick thread for sewing details
- Knitting needles for fixing the head
- Marker for marking the beginning of the row

Abbreviations

R = row

MR = magic ring

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc: double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

inc = increase (2 sc in one st)

dec = decrease (2 sc together)

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

F.o. = finish off

(...) = repeat the instructions in brackets the given number of times

[...] = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row



AMIGURUMI DOG FREE PATTERN

Ears (x 2)

R1. 8 sc in MR

R2. 8 inc (16)

R3. (1 sc, inc)*8 (24)

R4. (2 sc, inc)*8 (32)

R5-7. 32 (3 rows)

R8. (6 sc, dec)*4 (28)

R9. 28 sc

R10. (5 sc, dec)*4 (24)

R11. 24 sc

R12. (4 sc, dec)*4 (20)

R13. 20 sc

R14. (3 sc, dec)*4 (16)

R15. 16 sc

R16. (2 sc, dec)*4 (12)

R17. 12 sc

Fold in half, crochet 6 sc for two loops together. Fasten and cut the thread.



Nose

I leave at the beginning the long end of the thread in order to later embroider a strip under the spout.

R1. chain of 2 ch

R2. inc in the second loop from the hook (2)

We crochet in rotary rows

R3. 1 ch(s), 2 inc (4)

R4. 1 ch(s), (1 sc, inc) * 2 (6)

R5. 1 ch(s), (2 sc, inc) * 2 (8)

R6-7. 8 sc

Next, we make 1 ch and tie in a circle 5 sc on the first side, 1 sc in the base and 5 sc on the second side. We fix the thread and cut it off, leaving a long end for sewing.



Tail

R1. 6 sc in MR

R2. (2 sc, inc) * 2 (8)

R3. (3 sc, inc) * 2 (10)

R4-5. 10 sc (2 rows)

We fold the part in half, we crochet 5 sc for two loops together. We fasten the thread and cut it off.



Head

We start crocheting with a thread of an additional color.

R1. chain of 7 ch

R2. in the second loop from the hook 5 sc, 3 sc in the extreme loop, on the second side of the chain from ch we crochet 4 sc, inc (14)

R3. inc, 4 sc, 3 inc, 4 sc, 2 inc (20)

R4. (4 sc, inc) * 4 (24)

R5. (3 sc, inc) * 6 (30)

R6. 30 sc

Carefully knit 7 and 8 row!

R7. 4 sc, inc, we change the thread to the main color and we knit another (4 sc, inc) * 2, then 3 sc, 8 increases from hdc (!), 3 sc, inc (42)

R8. 21 sc, (1 hdc, inc from hdc) * 8 (!), 5 sc (50)

R9-12. 50 sc (4 rows)

R13. (23 sc, dec) * 2 (48)

We insert the eyes in the 7th row after the second and in the sixth increase. 14. (6 sc, dec) * 6 (42)

R15. (5 sc, dec) * 6 (36)

R16. (4 sc, dec) * 6 (30)

R17. (3 sc, dec) * 6 (24)

R18. (2 sc, dec) * 6 (18)

R19. (1 sc, dec) * 6 (12)

R20. 6 dec.



Pull the hole, fasten the thread and hide the tip inside the part.

Arms (x 2)

R1. 6 sc in MR
R2. 6 inc (12)
R3. (1 sc, inc) * 6 (18)
R4. 18 sc
R5. 6 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc (15)
R6. 5 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc (13)
R7-11. 13 sc (5 rows)
R12. 6 sc, dec, 5 sc (12)
R13. 5 sc, dec, 5 sc (11)
R14. 4 sc, dec, 5 sc (10)
R15-16. 10 sc



Fold in half, crochet 5 sc for two loops together. Fasten and cut the thread.

Legs (x 2)

We start crocheting with a thread of an additional color.

R1. 8 sc in MR
R2. 8 inc (16)
R3. (1 sc, inc) * 8 (24)
R4. (3 sc, inc) * 6 (30)
R5-6. 30 sc
R7. 6 sc, (1 sc, dec) * 6, 6 sc (24)
R8. 6 sc, 6 dec, 6 sc (18)

Change the thread to the thread of the main color.

R9-11. 18 sc (in a row)
R12. (4 sc, dec) * 3 (15)
R13-14. 15 sc (2 rows)
R15. (3 sc, dec) * 3 (12)
R16-19. 12 sc (4 rows)



Body

R1. 6 sc in MR
R2. 6 inc (12)
R3. 12 inc (24)
R4. (3 sc, inc) * 6 (30)
R5. (4 sc, inc) * 6 (36)
R6. (5 sc, inc) * 6 (42)
R7. (6 sc, inc) * 6 (48)
R8. (7 sc, inc) * 6 (54)

In the next row we crochet the legs and tail. The marker runs along the back.

R9. 9 sc, 6 sc with a leg, 24 sc, 6 sc with a leg, 6 sc, 3 sc With a tail (54) in the 10th row, we continue to crochet a tail. We divide the tail into 2 rows so that it is in the center of the back.

R10. 2 sc with tail, 12 sc, (2 sc, dec)*6, 15 sc (48)

R11. 48 sc

R12. 15 sc, (1 sc, dec) * 6, 15 sc (42)

R13-14. 42 sc (2 rows)

R15. (3 sc, dec) * 3, 12 sc, (3 sc, dec) * 3 (36)

R16. 12 sc, 6 dec, 12 sc (30)

R17. 30 sc

R18. (3 sc, dec) * 6 (24)

R19. 24 sc In the next row, we crochet handles. They should be exactly on the sides, if you can't, edit the location of the handles.

R20. 5 sc, 5 sc with a handle, 8 sc, 5 sc with a handle, 1 sc (24)

R21. (2 sc, dec) * 6 (18)

R22. 18 sc

Fasten the thread, if necessary, leave a long end for sewing on the head. I sew the head with nylon thread.

Assembly:

We make a tightening, as shown in the photo:



We embroider eyebrows, eyelids, sew on the nose and ears:
