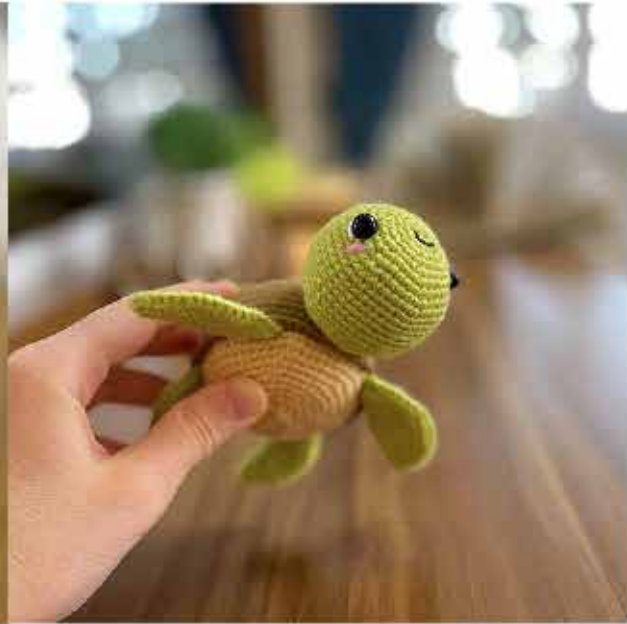

## Abbreviations

MR – amigurumi magic ring  
rnd – round  
sc – single crochet stitch  
BLO – crochet through back loops only  
dec – decrease  
inc – increase



## AMIGURUMI TURTLE FREE PATTERN

### Head

Begin with green color yarn

1 rnd: 6 sc in MR

2 rnd: 6 inc (12)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)

4 rnd: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)

6 rnd: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)

7 rnd: (5 sc, inc) x6 (42)

8 rnd: (6 sc, inc) x6 (48)

9 rnd-17 rnd: 48 sc (9 rounds)

18 rnd: (6 sc, dec) x6 (42)

19 rnd: (5 sc, dec) x6 (36)

20 rnd: (4 sc, dec) x6 (30)

21 rnd: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)

22 rnd: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)

Attach the eyes, 5 rows distance from the magic ring. Sew the smile



### Shell

Begin with brown color yarn

1 rnd: 6 sc in MR

2 rnd: 6 inc (12)

3 rnd: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)

4 rnd: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)

5 rnd: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)

6 rnd: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)

7 rnd: (5 sc, inc) x6 (42)

8 rnd: (6 sc, inc) x6 (48)

9 rnd: (7 sc, inc) x6 (54)

10 rnd: 54 sc (54)

11 rnd: (8 sc, inc) x6 (60)

12 rnd-17 rnd: 60 sc (6 rounds)



Change to the beige color yarn, don't cut the brown yarn, bring it to the outside.

- 18 md: BLO: 60 sc (60)
- 19 md: (8 sc, dec) x6 (54)
- 20 md: (7 sc, dec) x6 (48)
- 21 md: ( 6 sc, dec) x6 (42)
- 22 md: (5 sc, dec) x6 (36)
- 23 md: (4 sc, dec) x6 (30)
- 24 md: (3 sc, dec) x6 (24)
- 25 md: (2 sc, dec) x6 (18)
- 26 md: (1 sc, dec) x6 (12)
- 27 md: 6 dec (6)



Go back to the brown yarn that we left before and crochet 60 sc around

### Front legs (2 details)

Begin with green color yarn

- 1 rnd: 6 sc in MR
- 2 rnd: 6 inc (12)
- 3 rnd: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)
- 4 rnd: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
- 5 rnd: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
- 6 rnd: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)
- 7 rnd: (5 sc, inc) x6 (42)
- 1 sc, fold and crochet 20 sc together



### Hind legs (2 details)

Begin with green color yarn

- 1 rnd: 6 sc in MR
- 2 rnd: 6 inc (12)
- 3 rnd: (1 sc, inc) x6 (18)
- 4 rnd: (2 sc, inc) x6 (24)
- 5 rnd: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
- Fold and crochet 14 sc together



Sew the head to the shell.
