Materials

- Cotton yarn 8/3 (thin yarn) in colors: skin, dark blue, indigo blue, yellow, orange, pink, light brown, dark brown
- 1,2mm crochet hook
- 8mm safety eyes
- Soft wire or pipe cleaner
- Fiberfill
- False eyelashes
- Blush or pastel chalks

Stitches abbreviations

MR: Magic ring

Ch: Chain

st Stitch

SK Skip stitches

R: Round

SC: Single crochet

HDC: Half double crochet

SL: Slip stitch

INC: Increase of single crochet

INC2 Double increase of SC (3 sc in the same st)

DEC: Decrease of single crochet

DEC2 Double decrease of sc (close 3 st into one)

BLO: Back loop only

FLO: Front loop only

Arms (x2)

Start With Skin Color

1) MR, 6SC [6]

2) (2SC, INC)x2 [8]

3 - 4) 8SC (2 rounds) [8]

Change To Pink

5) BLO (3SC, INC)x2 [10]

6) 10SC [10]

Change To Orange

7-8) 10SC (2 rounds) [10]

Change To Pink

9 - 10) 10SC (2 rounds) [10]

Change To Orange

11 - 12) 10SC (2 rounds) [10]

Change To Pink 13 - 14)

10SC (2 rounds) [10]

Change To Orange

15 - 16) 10SC (2 rounds) [10]

Fasten off. Insert wire or pipe cleaner inside the arms if you want so.

Legs (x2)

Start With Dark Brown

1) MR, 6SC [6]

2) 6INC [12]

3) (1SC, INC)x6 [18]

Change To Yellow

3.5) BLO 18SL [18] (does not count as a R)

4) BLO 6SC, 3DEC, 6SC [15]

5 - 10) 15SC (6 rounds) [15]

11) FLO 15SC [15]

Cut The Yellow Yarn

With indigo blue, join yarn to the 1st st of the back loops of round 10 and make 15SC, now make:

12) (3SC, DEC)x3 [12]

13 - 18) 12SC (6 rounds) [12]

Fasten off just one leg. When you finish the second one, don't cut the yarn, then Ch 3 y join to the other leg with SL. IN the same st make 1SC (this will be the beginning of every R). Now make the body (do not cut the yarn)

Body

19) 11SC on one leg, 3SC on chains, 12SC on the other leg y 3SC on chains. [30]

20) (4SC, INC)x6 [36]

21) 6SC, INC, 17SC, INC, 11SC [38]

22-24) 38SC (3 rounds) [38]

25) 6SC, DEC, 17SC, DEC, 11SC [36]

26) (4SC, DEC)x6 [30]

27) 30SC [30]

28) (4SC, DEC)x5 [25]

Change To Pink

28.5) BLO 25 SL [25] (doesn't count as a R)

29 - 30) 25 SC (2 rounds) [25]

Change To Orange

31) (3 SC, DEC)x5 [20]

32) 20SC [20]

Change To Pink

33 - 34) 20SC (2 rounds) [20]

Change To Orange

35) (3SC, DEC)x4 [16]

36) 16SC [16]

37) Join the arms: flat each arm so the top of it is flatten and make: 3SC on body, 2SC joining one arm, skip 1 st on the arm and make 2SC joining the arm, 5SC on the body, 2SC joining one arm, skip 1 st on the arm and make 2SC joining the arm [16]

38) (2SC, DEC)x4 [12]

Change To Skin Color

39) BLO (4SC, DEC)x2 [10]

40) 10SC [10]

41) (3SC, DEC)x2 [8]

Do not fasten off. Now make the head:



Ears

- 1) MR, 5SC [5]
 - 2) 5INC [10]
- Fasten off and sew the ears at each side of the head.

Coat

Start With Yellow

- 1) 25CH, 24SC [24]
 - 2) 24SC [24]
 - 3) INC, 2SC, 6C, SK6, INC, 4SC, INC, 6C, SK6, 2SC, INC [28]
 - 4) 4SC, 6SC on chains, 8SC, 6SC on chains, 4SC [28]
 - 5) 3SC, (INC, 6SC)X3, INC, 3SC [32]
 - 6 - 7) 32SC (2 rounds) [32]
 - 8) INC, 10SC, INC, 8SC, INC, 10SC, INC [36]
 - 9 - 11) 36SC (3 rounds) [36]
 - 12) 8SC, INC, 5SC, INC, 6SC, INC, 5SC, INC, 8SC [40]
 - 13 - 19) 40SC (7 rounds) [40]
 - 20) 39SC, INC2, turn and make at the sides: 18SC, INC2, 2SC (place a st marker in the st that you just made), 20SC, INC2, 18SC, INC.
- Fasten off

SLEEVES

- Join yellow yarn to the unworked stitches of round 3 and make:
- 1 - 4) 14SC (4 rounds) [14]
 - 5) (GSC, INC)x2 [16]
 - 6 - 11) 16SC (6 rounds) [16] Fasten off

HOOD

- Join yarn in the stitch where you placed The st marker and make:
- 1) (1SC, INC)x 10 [30]
 - 2) 30SC [30]
 - 3) (2SC, INC)x10 [40]
 - 4-5) 40SC (2 rounds) [40]
 - 6) (3SC, INC)x10 [50]
 - 7-21) 50SC (15 rounds) [50]
- Fasten off

Join yarn in the 17th st of R 21 and make:

- 1) 18SC [18]
 - 2) INC, 16SC, INC [20]
 - 3-4) 20SC (2 rounds) [20]
 - 5) INC, 18SC, INC [22]
 - 6 - 15) 22SC (10 rounds) [22]
- Make SC all around the hood.

Head

- 1) FLO 8INC [16]
- 2) (1SC, INC)X8 [24]
- 3) (2SC, INC)X8 [32]
- 4) (3SC, INC)X8 [40]
- 5) (4SC, INC)X8 [48]
- 6) (7SC, INC)X6 [54]
- 7) (8SC, INC)X6 [60]
- 8 - 17) 60SC (10 rounds) [60]
- 18) (8SC, DEC)X6 [54]

Insert the safety eyes between 13 and 14 with 10 sts spacing.

- 19) (7SC, DEC)X6 [48]
- 20) (6SC, DEC)X6 [42]
- 21) (5SC, DEC)X6 [36]
- 22) (4SC, DEC)X6 [30]
- 23) (3SC, DEC)X6 [24]
- 24) (2SC, DEC)X6 [18]
- 25) (1SC, DEC)X6 [12]
- 26) 6DEC [6]

Fasten off.

Hair

Start With Dark Blue

1. MR, 8SC [8]
2. 8INC [16]
3. (1SC, INC)X8 [24]
4. (2SC, INC)X8 [32]

Now make the strands:

Strand from 1 to 22: 26CH, 1SC, 24HDC [25]

Strand from 23 to 25: 32Ch, 1SC, 30HDC [31]

Fasten off. Leave the remaining 7 stitches unworked. Sew the hair to the head, placing the longer strands next to the head.

Bag

Start With Light Brown

1) 9Ch, 8SC [8]

2 - 14) 8SC (13 rounds) [8]

15) DEC2, 2SC, DEC2 [4]

Do not turn your work, make SC all around the rectangle done, in every corner make INC2, then fasten off and leave a long tail. Fold the rectangle to a third, making this way the bag shape, sew on every side and so the lapel as well and fasten off. Join yarn on one side of the bag and make as many Ch as you want the long of the bag handle, and then join with SL to the other side. Fasten off.

Firefly

Start With Blue

Chain 9, and beginning from the 2nd Ch from your hook, make: 2SL, 2SC, 2HDC, 2DC [8]. Fasten off and leave a long tail. With pink color yarn, join to the 1st base chain and Ch 5, then from the 2nd chain from your hook, make 4HDC and join with SL to the next available st of the base chains (the ones in blue). Then chain 4 and make 3HDC. Fasten off. Repeat this on the other side, but beginning from the 3rd ST. Fasten off.

Glue or sew the firefly to Coraline's hair.
