## Materials

- 3-color thread: main, brown, beige
- 8mm safety eyes
- Hook # 2
- Silicone fleece for filling
- Pair of scissors
- Upholstery needle
- Black thread to embroider the eyebrows

## Abbreviations

- R = row  
MR = magic ring  
ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
dc: double crochet  
hdc = half double crochet  
sl st = slip stitch  
inc = increase (2 sc in one st)  
dec = decrease (2 sc together)

# AMIGURUMI GIRAFFE FREE PATTERN

## Head

- R1. 6 sc in MR (6)  
R2. 6 inc (12)  
R3. (sc, inc)\*6 (18)  
R4. (2 sc, inc)\*6 (24)  
R5. (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)  
R6. (2 sc, inc)\*10 (40)  
R7-10. 40 sc (4 rows)  
R11. (4 sc, inc)\*8 (48)  
R12-16. 48 sc (5 rows)  
R17. (6 sc, dec)\*6 (42)  
R18. (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)  
R19. (4 sc, dec)\*6 (30)  
R20. (sc, dec)\*10 (20)  
R21. (2 sc, dec)\*5 (15)  
Cut the thread, leave long end to sew



## Horns

- In brown color  
R1. 6 sc in MR (6)  
R2. (sc, inc)\*3 (9)  
R3. (2 sc, inc)\*3 (12)  
R4. 6 dec (6)  
Change to main color  
5-7. 6 sc (3 rows)  
Cut the thread, leave long end to sew

## Snout

- In beige  
R1. 6 sc in MR (6)  
R2. 6 inc (12)  
R3. (3 sc, 3 inc)\*2 (18)  
R4. 18 sc  
Cut the thread, leave long end to sew

## Ears

- R1. 4 sc in MR (4)  
R2. 4 inc (8)  
R3. (3 sc, inc)\*2 (10)  
R4. (4 sc, inc)\*2 (12)  
R5. (5 sc, inc)\*2 (14)  
R6-7. 14 sc (2 rows)  
R8. 7 dis (7)  
Fold and join both sides with 3 sc. Cut the thread, leave long end for sewing. Embroider the nose and eyebrows. Place the eyes between rows 12 and 13 with a distance between them 7 sc.

## Hands

- In brown color  
R1. 6 sc in MR (6)  
R2. 6 inc (12)  
R3. (3 sc, inc)\*3 (15)  
R4. 15 sc  
R5. (sc, dec)\*5 (10)  
Change to main color  
R6. (3 sc, dec)\*2 (8)  
R7-15. 8 sc (9 rows)  
Fold and join both sides with 4 sc. Cut the thread, leave long end for sewing.

## **Legs**

In brown color

R1. 6 sc in MR (6)

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3. (sc, inc)\*6 (18)

R4. 18 sc

R5. 6 sc, 3 dec, 6 sc (15)

R6. 5 sc, 3 dec, 4 sc (12)

Change to main color

R7-10. 12 sc (4 rows)

R11. (3 sc, inc)\*3 (15)

Cut the yarn on the first leg. Work an additional 5 to 6 sc on the second leg and begin to weave the body.

## **Body**

Chain 2 and join to the first leg

R1. (15 sc, 2 sc on the two chains)\*2 (34)

R2. 15 sc, 2 inc, 17 sc (36)

R3-7. 36 sc (5 rows)

R8. (10 sc, dec)\*3 (33)

R9. 33 sc

R10. (9 sc, dec)\*3 (30)

R11. 30 sc

R12. (8 sc, dec)\*3 (27)

R13. 27 sc

R14. (7 sc, dec)\*3 (24)

R15-16. 24 sc (2 rows)

R17. (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

R18. (4 sc, dec)\*3 (15)

R19-21. 15 sc (3 rows)

Close and cut the thread

## **Stains x 4**

R1. 1, 6 sc in MR (6)

R2. 1, 6 sc in MR 2, 6 inc (12)

R3-4. 1, 5 sc in MR 2, 5 inc (10)

Sew the spots to the body

## **Tail**

Ch 20 a chain and sl st in the first ch from hook.

Crochet then 1 eg in each remaining chain. Cut the thread and leave long end for sewing. For the tail brush, cut colored threads brown and tie them to one end.
