Materials

- Cotton ricorumi (dark pink, pink)
- Crochet hook: 3 mm
- Black embroidery thread
- Yarn needle
- Fiberfill for stuffing
- Safety eyes (6 mm)
- Stitch marker
- Scissors

Abbreviations

Rnd : round
MR: magic ring
Ch: chain
sl st: slip stitch
sc: single crochet
inc: increase
dec: decrease
BLO: back
FLO: front loop
()* : repeat till the end of round
[]: total number of stitches in the round

AMIGURUMI PIG FREE PATTERN

Legs & Body

Make 2.

Start in dark pink.

Rnd 1: MR, 8 sc [8]

Rnd 2: (inc)* [16]

Rnd 3-4: 16 sc [16]

Change to pink.

Rnd 5: 16 sc [16]

Rnd 6: (3 sc, inc)* [20]

Fasten off the first leg, don't cut the second.

Rnd 7: continue crocheting 10 sc on 2nd leg, join to the 1st leg with 1 sc, then 19 sc around the 1st leg, 10 sc on remaining stitches of 2nd leg [40]

The beginning of the Rnd is on the right side of the body.

Rnd 8: 40 sc [40]

Rnd 9: (4 sc, inc)* [48]

Rnd 10-13: 48 sc [48]

Rnd 14: (6 sc, dec)* [42]

Rnd 15-18: 42 sc [42]

Rnd 19: (5 sc, dec)* [36]

Rnd 20: 36 sc [36]

Rnd 21: (4 sc, dec)* [30]

Rnd 22: 30 sc [30]

Rnd 23: (3 sc, dec)* [24]

Head

In pink.

Make a ch 6, crochet around the ch, start in the 2nd ch from hook. Rnd 1: inc, 3 sc, 3 sc in last stitch, 4 sc [12]

Rnd 2: 2 inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 3 sc, inc [18]

Rnd 3: (2 sc, inc)* [24]

Rnd 4: (3 sc, inc)* [30]

Rnd 5: (2 sc, inc, 2 sc)* [36]

Rnd 6: (5 sc, inc)* [42]

Rnd 7-13: 42 sc [42]

Rnd 14: 2 sc, 4 inc, 17 sc, 4 inc, 15 sc [50]

Rnd 15-20: 50 sc [50]

Rnd 21: 2 sc, 4 dec, 17 sc, 4 dec, 15 sc [42]

Rnd 22: (dec, 2 sc) x 3, 9 sc, (dec, 2 sc) x 3, 9 sc [36] R

Rnd 23: (dec, 1 sc) x 3, 9 sc, (dec, 1 sc) x 3, 9 sc [30]

Rnd 24: (3 sc, dec)* [24]

Stuff firmly.

Ears x2

In pink

Rnd 1: MR, 6 sc [6]

Rnd 2: (2 sc, inc)* [8]

Rnd 3: (3 sc, inc)* [10]

Rnd 4: (4 sc, inc)* [12]

Rnd 5: (5 sc, inc)* [14]

Rnd 6: (6 sc, inc)* [16]

Fold in half and crochet 8 sc through both sides.

Arms x2

Start in dark pink.

Rnd 1: MR, 6 sc [6]

Rnd 2: (inc)* [12]

Rnd 3: BLO - 12 sc [12]

Rnd 4: 12 sc [12]

Change to pink.

Rnd 5-9: 12 sc [12]

Stuff.

Rnd 10: (4 sc, dec)* [10]

Rnd 11-12 : 10 sc [10]

Rnd 13: (3 sc, dec)* [8]

Fold in half and crochet 4 sc through both sides.

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Muzzle

In dark pink

Make a ch 5, crochet around the chain, starting in 2nd ch from hook.

Rnd 1: inc, 2 sc, 3 sc in last stitch, 3 sc [10]

Rnd 2: inc, 3 sc, inc, 5 sc [12] 1 sl st.

If you don't want a flat nose, don't make the sl st at the end and continue crocheting:

Rnd 3: BLO - 12 sc [12]

Rnd 4: 12 sc [12] 1 sl st.

Fasten off, embroider the nostrils with black thread, sew or glue to the head.

Tail

In pink.

Ch 7:6 inc, fasten off and sew at the back.
