Materials:

1. Any textured or semi-cotton yarn.
2. Hook suitable for your yarn.
3. A small piece of wire.
4. Filler.
5. Eyes.
6. Good mood.

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

inc = increase (2 sc in one st)

dec = decrease (2 sc together)

BLO = back loop only

FLO = front loop only

F.o. = finish off

(...) = repeat the instructions in brackets the given number of times

[...] = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

Abbreviations:

MR – Amigurumi Magic ring
ch = chain



AMIGURUMI WHALE FREE PATTERN

Fins:

1. 6sc in MR
2. (1sc,inc)*3 = 9sc
3. (2sc,inc)*3 = 12sc
4. 12sc
5. (3sc,inc)*3 = 15sc
6. 15sc
7. (3sc,dec)*3 = 12sc
8. (2sc,dec)*3 = 9sc
9. (1sc,dec)*3 = 6sc
10. Fold in half and knit 3 sc. Leave the thread for sewing. We do not fill.



Body:

1. 6sc in MR
 2. 6inc = 12sc
 3. (1sc,inc)*6 = 18sc
 4. (2sc,inc)*6 = 24sc
 5. (3sc,inc)*6 = 30sc
 6. (4sc,inc)*6 = 36sc
 7. (5sc,inc)*6 = 42sc
 8. 42sc
 9. (6sc,inc)*6 = 48sc
 10. 48sc
 11. (7sc,inc)*6 = 54sc
 - 12-18. 54sc
 19. (7sc,dec)*6 = 48sc
 20. 48sc
 21. (6sc,dec)*6 = 42sc
 22. 42sc
- We fix the wire. We sew not tight, otherwise it will be visible on the pug. The wire dangles freely.
23. (5sc,dec)*6 = 36sc
 24. 14sc, 4dec, 14sc = 32sc
 25. 32sc
 26. 12sc, 4dec, 12sc = 28sc
 - 27-28. 28sc. Stuff.

29. 12sc, 2dec, 12sc = 26sc
30. 26sc
31. 11sc, 2dec, 11sc = 24sc
32. 24sc
33. (4sc,dec)*4 = 20sc
34. 20sc. Add filler.
35. (3sc,dec)*4 = 16sc
36. 16sc
37. (2sc,dec)*4 = 12sc
38. 12sc
39. (1sc,dec)*4 = 8sc
40-43. 8sc
We close the loops.



Tail:

1. 6sc in MR
2. 5sc, inc = 7sc
3. 6sc, inc = 8sc
4. 7sc, inc = 9sc
5. 3sc, inc, 3sc, 2inc = 12sc
6. 4sc, inc, 4sc, 2inc, 1sc = 15sc
7. 11sc, 2inc, 2sc = 17sc
8. 12sc, 2inc, 3sc = 19sc
9. 13sc, 2inc, 4sc = 21sc
10. 14sc, 2inc, 5sc = 23sc
11. 15sc, 2inc, 6sc = 25sc
- 12-14. 25sc
15. (3sc,dec)*5 = 20sc
16. (2sc,dec)*5 = 15sc
17. (1sc,dec)*5 = 10sc
18. 5dec = 5sc We close the loops.



Leave the thread for sewing. We don't stuff. Sew to the body.

Insert eyes. We sew eyelids. Sew on the fins. Our baby whale is ready.
