Materials

- Yarn (I use Alize cotton gold)
- Crochet hook according to the yarn (my hook no: 2mm)
- Embroidery thread
- 5 mm safety eyes
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Tapestry and embroidery needles
- Scissors
- Pins

Abbreviations

- MR: Magic ring
- Ch: Chain
- Dec: Decrease
- Inc: Increase
- Rnd: Round
- Sc: Single crochet
- Slst: Slip stitch
- Skill level: Easy



AMIGURUMI BEAR FREE PATTERN

Head

- Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR (6)
- Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)
- Rnd 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
- Rnd 4. (2sc,inc)*6 (24)
- Rnd 5. (3sc,inc)*6 (30)
- Rnd 6. (4sc,inc)*6 (36)
- Rnd 7. (5sc,inc)*6 (42)

- Rnd 20. (2sc,dec)*6 (18)

Slst and fasten off leaving a long yarn tail. Stuff the head.

Ears

Make two details

- Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR (6)
- Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)
- Rnd 3. sc in all 12 st (12)

Slst and fasten off leaving a long yarn tail.



Sew the ears to the head between rounds 6 to 9 of the head.

Embroider eyebrows and nose.



- Rnd 8. (6sc,inc)*6 (48)
 - Rnd 9-15. 48 sc (48)
 - Rnd 16. (6sc,dec)*6 (42)
 - Rnd 17. (5sc,dec)*6 (36)
 - Rnd 18. (4sc,dec)*6 (30)
- Insert safety eyes between rounds 10 and 11, 3 st apart.
- Rnd 19. (3sc,dec)*6 (24)

Legs and body

Stuff in the process.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR
Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)
Rnd 3. (1sc,inc)*6 (18)
Rnd 4. 18 sc (18)
Rnd 5. 8sc, (1sc,dec)*3, 1 sc (15)
Rnd 6. 11 sc, dec, 2 sc (14)
Rnd 7. 14 sc (14)
Slst and fasten off.

Crochet the second leg, do not fasten off.
Make 3 ch and join with the first leg in 8th st of the last round.
Continue crocheting the body in the round:



Rnd 8. 14 sc on the first leg, 3 sc in 3 ch, 14 sc on the second leg, 3 sc in 3 ch (opposite side) (34)
Rnd 9. 31 sc, inc, sc, inc (36)
Rnd 10-11. 36 sc (36)
Rnd 12. 7 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 11 sc (34)
Rnd 13. 34 sc (34)
Rnd 14. 7 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 11 sc (32)
Rnd 15. 32 sc (32)
Rnd 16. 6 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, 8 sc (30)
Rnd 17. 30 sc (30)
Rnd 18. 5 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec, 8 sc (28)
Rnd 19. 5 sc, dec, 12 sc, dec, 7 sc (26)
Rnd 20. 5 sc, dec, 11 sc, dec, 6 sc (24)
Rnd 21. (2sc,dec)*6 (18)
Crochet additional 7 sc, slst, fasten off and weave the yarn end in.



Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR
Rnd 2. (1sc,inc)*3 (9)
Rnd 3-5. 9 sc (9)
Rnd 6. (1sc,dec)*3 (6)
Rnd 7-10. 6 sc (6)
Stuff a little.
Tighten the hole, leaving a long yarn tail.



Scarf

Make 61 ch. From the 2nd ch from hook: 60 sc.
Fasten off.



Sew the head to the body.
Sew the arms between rounds 19 to 20 of the body.



Your mini bear is ready!
