## Materials:

- Mohair or cotton yarn
- 1.25 mm crochet hook
- Black beads or safety eyes
- Plastic safety nose
- Pink embroidery floss for cheeks
- Black embroidery floss for muzzle
- Sewing needle, scissors
- Fiberfill
- Keychain ring

## Abbreviations:

R – row  
ch – chain  
sc – single crochet  
sl st – slip stitch  
inc – increase (2 sc in one stitch)  
dec – decrease (2 sc together)  
[...] – number of stitches you should have at the end of the row  
(...) – repeat whatever is between the brackets the given number of times

# TEDDY BEAR AMIGURUMI KEYCHAIN FREE PATTERN

## Head

Make 12 ch. Make an oval, starting from the 2nd ch from hook, work on both sides of the chain.

R 1: from the 2nd ch from hook: 10 sc, 3 sc in last st, turn: 9 sc, inc [24]

R 2: inc, 9 sc, 3 inc, 9 sc, 2 inc [30]

R 3: inc, 10 sc, inc, (1 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 10 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 1 sc [36]

R 4: 2 sc, inc, 11 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 11 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc [42]

R 5: 1 sc, inc, 12 sc, inc, (3 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 12 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 2 sc [48]

R 6: 3 sc, inc, 13 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 13 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 1 sc [54]

R 7: 54 sc

R 8: 2 sc, inc, 14 sc, inc, (5 sc, inc) repeat 2 times, 14 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 3 sc [60]

R 9-21: 60 sc (13 rows)

R 22: 2 sc, dec, 14 sc, dec, (5 sc, dec) repeat 2 times, 14 sc, dec, 5 sc, dec 3 sc [54]

R 23: (7 sc, dec) repeat 6 times (48)

R 24: (dec) repeat 24 times [24]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Body

R 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

R 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

R 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat 6 times [18]

R 4: (2 sc, inc) repeat 6 times [24]

R 5: (3 sc, inc) repeat 6 times [30]

R 6: (4 sc, inc) repeat 6 times [36]

R 7-12: 36 sc (6 rows)

R 13: (4 sc, dec) repeat 6 times [30]

R 14: 30 sc

R 15: (3 sc, dec) repeat 6 times [24]

R 16: 24 sc, sl st

Fasten off.

## Arms (make 2)

R 1: 7 sc in magic ring [7]

R 2-6: 7 sc (5 rows)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Ears (make 2)

R 1: 5 sc in magic ring [5], turn

R 2: (inc) repeat 5 times [10], sl st

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Muzzle

R 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

R 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

R 3: (1 sc, inc) repeat 6 times, sl st [18]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Legs (make 2)

Make 5 ch. Make an oval, starting from the 2nd ch from hook, work on both sides of the chain.

R 1: from the 2nd ch from hook: 3 sc, 3 sc in last st, turn: 2 sc, inc [10]

R 2: inc, 2 sc, 3 inc, 2 sc, 2 inc [16]

R 3-4: 16 sc (2 rows)

R 5: 4 sc, 3 dec, 4 sc, dec [12]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Tail

R 1: 6 sc in magic ring [6]

R 2: (inc) repeat 6 times [12]

R 3: (1 sc, dec) repeat 4 times, sl st [8]

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.
