Materials and tools

- Yarn (for body)
- Grass yarn (for needles)
- Hook 3.5 mm
- Eyes for toys
- Filler for toys
- Needle for sewing details
- Scissors

Abbreviations:

- MR - magic ring
- ch - chain
- sc - single crochet
- dec - decrease
- inc - increase
- BLO - back loop only
- FLO - front loop only
- F.o. - finish off
- (...) - repeat the instructions in brackets the given number of times
- [...] - number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

AMIGURUMI HEDGEHOG FREE PATTERN

Legs

1 row: 6 sc in MR (6)
2 row: 6 inc (12)
3 row: (inc, 5 sc) x 2 (14)
4 row: 14 sc (14)
5 row: 5 dec, 4 sc (9)
6-8 row: we knit without changes 9 sc 3 rows (9)
9 row: left leg 8 sc, inc (10), right leg 5 sc, inc, 3 sc
10 row: 10 sc (10)

Cut the thread on the left leg, and leave the thread on the right leg for further knitting.

Body

11 row: 4 sc (on the right leg), 4 ch, 10 sc (on the left leg), 4 inc, 6 sc (on the right leg) (32)
12-20 row: we knit without changes 32 sc 9 rows (32)
21 row: 20 sc, 4 dec (decreases exactly on the tummy) sc (28)
22 row: 28 sc (28)
23 row: (5 sc, dec) x 4 (24)
24 row: 24 sc (24)
25 row : (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)
26 row: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

Head

27 row: 12 inc (24)
28 row: (1 sc, inc) x 12 (36)
29 row: 25 sc, 4 inc, 3 sc, 4 inc (44)
30-32 row: knit unchanged 44 sc 3 rows (44)
33rd row: 25 sc, 4 dec, 3 sc, 4 dec (36)
34-35 row: we knit without changes 36 sc 2 rows (36)

In the 35th row, insert the eyes, focusing on the increase for the cheeks, the gap between the eyes is 5 columns.36 row: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

37 row: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)
38 row: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)
39 row: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)
40 row: 6 dec (6)

Cut the thread, pull the hole and hide the thread.

Nose

1 row: 6 sc in MR (6)
2-3 row: 6 sc 2 rows (6)

Fill a little, pull the hole. Fasten the thread and leave the end for sewing.

Handles

1 row: 6 sc in MR (6)
2-9 row: 6 sc 8 rows (6)

Fold and knit 3 sc. Cut the thread and leave the end for sewing.

Ears

1 row: 6 sc in MR
2-3 row: 6 sc 2 rows (6)

Fold and knit 2 sc. Fasten the thread and cut.

Needles on the head

We knit with Grass yarn and crochet 3.5 mm.

1 row: 6 sc in MR (6)
2 row: 6 inc (12)
3 row: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4-6 row: 18 sc 3 rows (18)
7 row: 5 sc, 2 sc (together with the ear), 4 sc, 2 sc (together with the ear), 5 sc (18)

Cut the thread, fasten. Comb.

Needles on the back

1 row: 4 ch, in the 2nd loop: inc, 1 sc, 4 sc in 1 loop, 1 sc, inc (10)
2 row: 2 inc, 1 sc, 4 inc, 1 sc, 2 inc (18)
3 row: (1 sc, inc) x 2, 1 sc, (1 sc, inc) x 4, 1 sc, (1 sc, inc) x 2 (26)
4 row: 2 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, 2 sc (34)

Cut the thread and fasten off. Comb.



Assembling

- We do eye tightening. So that they drown a little. We introduce the thread at the back of the head, pass it under one eye, bring it back to the back of the head, and fasten it. We do the same with the other eye.
- Next, sew on the nose, placing it like a droplet between the eyes. So that the high point of the nose is in the middle of the pupil.
- Sew on the handles. From the neck 2 rows down. We sew diagonally. So that they folded on the tummy.
- Sew on a wig (needles). I sew with ordinary sewing thread, so that the ears are symmetrically located on the sides.
- We place a fur coat (needles) on the back across the back and sew it on, slightly stretching the fabric.
