## **Materials:**

- Yarn: Himalaya Dolphin Baby #80301 (white), #80319 (pink)
- Hook size: 3.5 mm
- 25 mm safety eyes
- Plastic safety nose
- Stitch marker
- Thin thread or yarn in the tone of yarn for sewing details
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Fiberfill

## **Abbreviations:**

- R = row
- mc = magic circle
- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- inc = 2 sc in the next stitch
- dec = single crochet 2 stitches together
- (12) = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row
- (...) \* 6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

# AMIGURUMI LEMUR FREE CROCHET PATTERN

## Legs (make 2)

With pink yarn:

R 1: 4 sc in mc (4)

R 2-3: 4 sc, sl st

Stuff gently with fiberfill.

F.o.

## Arms (make 2)

With pink yarn:

R 1: 4 sc in mc (4)

R 2: 4 sc

Change to white yarn:

R 3: 4 sc

R 4-5: 4 sc, sl st

F.o.

## Ears (make 2)

With pink yarn:

Make 6 ch.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 5 sc, turn

R 2: 4 sc, turn

R 3: 3 sc, turn

R 4: 2 sc, turn

R 5: 1 sc

Make sc around edges of ear with white yarn.

## Head

With white yarn:

R 1: 8 sc in mc (8)

R 2: (inc) \* 8 (16)

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 8 (24)

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 8 (32)

R 5: (3 sc, inc) \* 8 (40)

R 6-7: 40 sc (2 rows)

R 8: attach ears: 2 sc, 7 sc together with sc of the 1st ear (left), 18 sc, 7 sc together with sc of the 2nd ear (right), 6 sc (40)

R 9: 40 sc

R 10: (3 sc, dec) \* 8 (32)

R 11: (2 sc, dec) \* 8 (24)

Insert safety eyes on R 3 from the center.

Stuff with fiberfill.

R 12: (1 sc, dec) \* 8 (16)

R 13: (dec) \* 8 (8)

## Body

With white yarn:

R 1: 8 sc in mc (8)

R 2: (inc) \* 8 (16)

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 8 (24)

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 8 (32)

R 5: BLO. Attach legs (4 sc between legs): 12 sc, 2 sc together with sc of the 1st leg (left), 4 sc, 2 sc together with sc of the 2nd leg (right), 12 sc (32)

R 6: 32 sc

R 7: (2 sc, dec) \* 8 (24).

R 8: 24 sc

R 9: (1 sc, dec) \* 8 (16)

R 10: 16 sc

R 11: 3 sc, 2 sc together with sc of the 1st arm (left), 7 sc, 2 sc together with sc of the 2nd arm (right), 2 sc (16)

R 12: 16 sc

Stuff with fiberfill.

F.o.

Sew head to the body.



## Tail

With pink yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: 6 sc

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 3 (9)

R 4: 9 sc

Change to white yarn:

R 5-8: 9 sc (4 rows)

Change to pink yarn:

R 9-12: 9 sc (4 rows)

Change to white yarn:

R 13-15: 9 sc (3 rows)

Change to pink yarn:

R 16-20: 9 sc (5 rows)

Fold top of tail flat and 4 sc through both sides across.

## Muzzle

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (1 sc, inc) \* 3 (9)

F.o.

Insert safety nose and sew the muzzle to the head.

Sew tail to the body.
