## Materials

- Yarn depends on your choice. (I used Alize Superlana Klasik 280m/100g, colors 144)
- 2mm crochet hook (or another convenient hook for you)
- Eyes 8mm.
- Toys stuffing, scissors, stitch maker, needle and dollmaking needle

## Abbreviations

- MR – Amigurumi Magic ring
- App – application
- ll – lift loop
- sc : Single Crochet
- inc : Increase
- dec : Decrease

tr : Triple Crochet/ Treble Crochet

st: Stitch

dc : Double Crochet

hdc: Half Double Crochet

sl-st : Slip Stitch

ch : Chain

..in : make increase into same stitch as many as the number which is given in front of “inc” abbreviation (exp; 3inc, 4inc..).

FLO : Crochet into front loops only

BLO : Crochet into back loops only

BL : Bobble Stitch – do 5dc all in the same stitch and then yarn over and pull through all the loops on your hook (the original loop + 1 loop for each partially completed dc).

FO = fasten off.



## AMIGURUMI HIPPO FREE PATTERN

1. -Ch 10, working in 2nd chain from hook: 1 inc, 3sc, 1 ins, 3sc, 4sc in 1 st, 7sc, 1 inc=23
2. -2inc, 3 sc, 2inc, 3sc, 4inc, 7sc, 2inc =33
3. -2sc, (1inc, 6sc)\*2, 1inc, 2sc, 2inc, 10sc, 2inc =40
4. -10sc, 1inc, 29sc =40
5. -3sc, 1inc, (7sc, 1inc)x2, 21sc =44
6. -6sc, 5-dc popcorn, 12sc, 5-dc popcorn, 24sc =44
- 7-10. -44sc =44
11. -2sc, 2dec, 6sc, 1dec, 6sc, 2dec, 20sc =30
12. -2sc, 1dec, 5sc, 2dec, 5sc, 1dec, 19sc =35
13. -35sc =35
14. -6 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 22 sc = 37.
15. -7sc 1inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc = 39.
16. -8 sc, 1 inc. 5 sc, 1 inc, 24 sc = 41.
17. -9sc, 1 inc. 5 sc, 1 inc, 25 sc = 43.
18. -10sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 26 sc = 45.
19. -11sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 27 sc = 47.
20. -12sc, 1 inc. 5 sc, I inc, 28 sc = 49.
21. -13sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, I inc, 29 sc = 51.
22. - 14 sc. I inc. 5 sc, 1 inc, 30 sc = 53.
- 23-27. -53 sc = 53.
28. -(9sc ,1dec) x 3, ( 8 sc, 1 dec )x 2 =48.
29. -( 6sc, 1dec)x 6=42.
30. -3sc, 1dec,( 5sc, 1dec)x5,2 sc=36.
31. -( 4 sc,1 dec)x 6=30.
32. -1sc, 1dec, (3sc, 1dec)x5, 2 sc=24.
33. -(2sc, 1dec)x6=18.

34. - ( 1 sc, 1 dec ) x 6= 12.

35. - 6 dec 6.

FO and hide the yam tail.

### Ears (2)

1. -6sc in MR =6

2. -6inc =12

3-5. -12sc =12

FO and leave a yarn tail for sewing the ears onto the head.

### Head Decoration

1. Sew the ears between rounds 25-26 of the head.

2. Embroider eyebrows, white of eyes nostrils, mouth.



## Body

1. – 6 sc in MR
2. – 6 inc = 12.
3. – (1 sc, 1inc) x 6 = 18.
4. – (2 sc, 1inc) x 6 = 24.
5. – (3 sc, 1inc) x 6 = 30.
6. – (4 sc, 1inc)x 6 =36.
7. – (5 sc, 1inc) x 6 = 42.
8. – (6 sc, 1inc)x6 =48.
9. – (7 sc, 1inc)x 6=54.
- 10-11. – 54 sc = 54.
12. – 15 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 15 sc = 52.
13. -14 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 14 sc = 50.
14. -13 sc, 1 dec. 20 sc, 1 dec, 13 sc = 48.
15. – 12 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 12 sc = 46.
16. – 11 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 11 sc = 44.
17. -10 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 42.
18. -10 sc, 1 dec, 18 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 40.
19. -10 sc, 1 dec, 16 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 38.
20. -10 sc, 1 dec, 14 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 36.
21. -10 sc, 1 dec, 12 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 34.
22. -10 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 32.
23. -10 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 30.
24. -10 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 28.
25. -10 sc. 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 26.
26. -10 sc, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc = 24.
27. -10 sc, 2 dec, 10 sc = 22.
- 28-30. – 22 = 22.

FO and leave a yarn tail for sewing the body onto the head.

## Legs

- 1.- Ch 5, working in 2nd chain from hook 1 inc, 2 sc, 4 sc in 1 st, 2 sc, 1 inc. = 12.
2. -1 inc, 4 sc, 2 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc. = 16.
- 3-9. – 16 sc. = 16.
10. – 3 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc = 18.
11. – 4 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc. 10 sc = 20.
12. – 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc. 1 inn, 11 sc = 22.
13. – 6 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc. 1 inc. 12 sc = 24.
14. – 7 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc. 13 sc = 26.
15. – 8 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc. 1 inc, 14 sc = 28.
16. – 9 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc. 15 sc = 30.
- 17-18. – 30 sc 30.
19. – (3 sc, 1 dec)x6 =24.
20. – (2 sc, 1 dec)x6 = 18.
21. – (1 sc, 1 dec)x6 =12.

## Hands (2)

1. – 6 sc in MR
  2. – 6 inc =12.
  3. – ( 1sc 1inc) x 6 = 18.
  - 4-7. – 18 sc = 18.
  8. – 5sc, 4dec, 5sc =14.
  9. – 5sc, 2dec, 5sc = 12.
  - 10-19. – 12 sc = 12.
  20. – 6 dec = 6.
- FO and hide the yarn tail.

## Tail

1. – 6 sc in MR
2. – (1 inc, 2 sc)x2 = 8.
3. – (1 inc, 3 sc)x2 = 10.
4. – (1 inc, 4 sc)x2 = 12.
5. – (1 inc, 5 sc)x2 = 14.
6. – (1 inc, 6 sc)x2 = 16.
- 7-8. – 16 sc = 16.

Fold in half and sc 8 through both sides.  
FO and leave a yarn tail for sewing the tail onto the body.

How to assemble hippo.

1. Sew the head to the body.
2. Sew the legs and hands to the body.
3. Sew the tail to the body.
