## **Pattern Details**

*Size:*

16 inches from foot to top of head with weight 4 yarn and a 3.25 mm hook

*Skill Level Needed:*

Intermediate- suitable for novice crocheters, requires patience and precisions when assembling the giraffe and basic crochet skills.

## **Materials Needed:**

Yarn: Worsted Weight #4, approximately 100g of main color, 50-75g of accent colors

Color A: Light Gray, Color B: Yellow, Color C: Dark Gray

Hook Size: D Hook or 3.25 mm

15 mm safety eyes

Scissors, sewing needle, stitch marker, fiberfill stuffing

Gray felt(Optional)

## **Abbreviations:**

mr= magic ring- crochet single crochet stitches in to the adjustable loop

ch= chain stitch

sc= single crochet stitch

sl= slip stitch

dc= double crochet stitch

inc= increase- make two single crochet stitches in the same stitch

dec=decrease- crochet two stitches together using the decrease method

(4 sc, inc) x 6= repeat the pattern between parentheses 6 times

BLO= back loops only

inc3= 3 sc in the same stitch

F/O= Fasten off



## AMIGURUMI GIRAFFE FREE PATTERN

### Notes:

- Do not join rounds unless stated, work in a continuous spiral
- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round
- All stitches are worked in both loops unless stated otherwise in the pattern

### Head:

Crocheted from front of nose to back of head

With Color A:

Ch 9

1. Sc in the 2nd chain from hook, 5 sc, inc3 in next chain, sc in the next chain, working on the opposite side of the chain: 5 sc, inc3= 18
  2. (6 sc, inc x 3) x 2= 24
  3. 7 sc, inc, sc, inc, sc, inc, 7 sc, inc, sc, inc, sc, inc= 30
  4. (inc, 4 sc) x 6= 36
  5. (inc, 5 sc) x 6= 42
  6. (inc, 6 sc) x 6= 48
  7. (inc, 7 sc) x 6= 54
  - 8-12. sc around
  13. (7 sc, dec) x 6= 48
  14. (6 sc, dec) x 6= 42
  15. (5 sc, dec) x 6= 36
- Change to Color B:
16. 12 sc, (3 sc, inc) x 6= 42
  17. 12 sc, (4 sc, inc) x 6= 48
  18. 12 sc, (5 sc, inc) x 6= 54
  19. 12 sc, (6 sc, inc) x 6= 60
  - 20-27. sc around
- Place eyes between rounds 16 and 17 leaving 12

holes between. Make sure you place the eyes in the middle of the increases instead of where the 12 scs are.

28. (8 sc, dec) x 6= 54
29. (7 sc, dec) x 6= 48
30. (6 sc, dec) x 6= 42
31. (5 sc, dec) x 6= 36
32. (4 sc, dec) x 6= 30
33. (3 sc, dec) x 6= 24
34. (2 sc, dec) x 6= 18
35. (1 sc, dec) x 6= 12
36. dec x 6= 6

F/O and sew the opening of the head closed

### Body:

With Color B: Starting with Color C:

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring= 6
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x 6= 18
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6= 24
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6= 30
6. (4 sc, inc) x 6= 36
7. (5 sc, inc) x 6= 42
8. (6 sc, inc) x 6= 48
9. (7 sc, inc) x 6= 54
10. (8 sc, inc) x 6= 60
11. (9 sc, inc) x 6= 66
- 12.-18. Sc in each st around
19. (9 sc, dec) x 6= 60
- 20-21. sc in each st around
22. (8 sc, dec) x 6= 54
- 23-24. Sc in each st around
25. (7 sc, dec) x 6= 48

Start stuffing the body  
26-27. sc in each st around  
28. (6 sc, dec) x 6= 42  
29-30. sc in each st around  
31. (5 sc, dec) x 6= 36  
32-33. sc in each st around  
34. (4 sc, dec) x 6= 30  
35. (3 sc, dec) x 6= 24  
36-46. sc in each st around  
47. 8 sc, 2 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 8 sc  
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

#### **Tail:**

1. Make 4 sc into a magic ring= 4
2. Inc x 4= 8
3. Sc in each st around
4. (sc, inc) x 4= 12
5. (2 sc, inc) x 4= 16
6. (3 sc, inc) x 4= 20
- 7-8. Sc in each st around
9. (3 sc, dec) x 4= 16
10. (2 sc, dec) x 4= 12
11. (sc, dec) x 4= 8

Stop stuffing the tail  
Change to Color B:  
12-26. Sc in each st around  
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

#### **Ears (Make 2):**

With Color B:

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring= 6
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. sc in each st around
4. (3 sc, inc) x 3= 15
5. sc in each st around
6. (4 sc, inc) x 3= 18

Do not stuff the ears  
7-11. sc in each st around  
12. (4 sc, dec) x 3= 15  
13. Sc in each st around  
14. (3 sc, dec) x 3= 12  
sc the ear closed and F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

#### **Arms (Make 2):**

Starting with Color C:

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring= 6
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x 6= 18
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6= 24
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6= 30
6. BLO sc in each st around
- 7-8. sc in each st around
9. (3 sc, dec) x 6= 24

Change to Color B:

10. BLO sc in each st around
11. sc in each st around
12. (6 sc, dec) x 3= 21
- 13-14. sc in each st around
15. (5 sc, dec) x 3= 18
- 16-17. sc in each st around

Start stuffing the arms  
18. (4 sc, dec) x 3= 15  
19-20. sc in each st around  
21. (3 sc, dec) x 3= 12  
22-23. sc in each st around  
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing  
\*If you single crochet the arms and legs  
Closed, sewing will be much easier

#### **Legs (Make 2):**

Starting with Color C:

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring= 6
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x 6= 18
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6= 24
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6= 30
6. (4 sc, inc) x 6= 36
7. BLO sc in each st around
- 8-9. Sc in each st around
10. (4 sc, dec) x 6= 30

Change to Color B:

11. BLO sc in each st around
12. Sc in each st around
13. (8 sc, dec) x 3= 27
- 14-15. Sc in each st around
16. (7 sc, dec) x 3= 24
- 17-18. Sc in each st around
19. (6 sc, dec) x 3= 21
- 20-21. Sc in each st around
22. (5 sc, dec) x 3= 18
- 23-24. Sc in each st around

Start stuffing the legs  
25. (4 sc, dec) x 3= 15  
26-27. Sc in each st around  
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

#### **Horns (Make 2):**

Starting with Color C:

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring= 6
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x 6= 18
4. (5 sc, inc) x 3= 21
- 5-6. sc in each st around
7. (5 sc, dec) x 3= 18
8. (sc, dec) x 6= 12
9. dec x 6= 6

Change to Color B:  
10-16. Sc in each st around  
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing



## ASSEMBLY

### *Head and Body:*

1. Pin the horns onto the head approximately between rounds 22 and 23 of the head. Sew the horns onto the head. Pin the ears about 4 stitches away from the horns on the side of the head and sew into place. Embroider some nostrils with dark gray yarn approximately between rounds 6 and 7 of the head.
2. Pin the head to the body for extra support. You may need to add more stuffing as you sew. (Make sure the double crochets from round 47 are on the back of the head.)
3. Sew the head to the body.



### *Arms:*

1. Pin the arms onto the side of the body. I do not have particular rounds I place these on. I just make sure they are facing forward and are on the side of the body slightly underneath the beginning of the neck.
2. Sew the arms onto the body.



### *Legs:*

1. Turn the body upside down with the nose facing away from you. Pin the legs underneath the body approximately between rounds 5 and 6.
2. Sew the legs onto the body.



### *Tail and spots:*

1. Pin the tail onto the back of the body approximately between rounds 17 and 18.
2. Sew the tail onto the body.
3. Cut many shapes out of dark gray felt and glue or sew onto the body.
4. Cut the ear shapes out of light gray felt and sew or glue them into the ears.
