## **Materials:**

- Yarn: YarnArt Jeans, Gazzal Jeans or Alize Baby Cotton (grey, white and any color for a sweater)
- Hook size: 2.0 mm
- 8 mm safety eyes
- Pink embroidery thread or fine yarn for a nose
- Sewing needle and scissors
- Fiberfill

## **Abbreviations:**

- R = row
- mc = magic circle
- ch = chain
- st = stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- inc = 2 sc in the next stitch
- dec = single crochet 2 stitches together
- BLO = back loop only
- F.o. = finish off
- () = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row
- ()\*6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated



## AMIGURUMI BUNNY FREE PATTERN

### Head

With grey yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)\*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)\*6 (18)

R 4: (1 sc, inc)\*9 (27)

R 5: 27 sc

R 6: (2 sc, inc)(9 (36)

R 7-8: 36 sc (2 rows)

R 9: (5 sc, inc)\*6 (42)

R 10-11: 42 sc (2 rows)

R 12: (6 sc, inc)\*6 (48)

R 13-14: 48 sc (2 rows)

Insert safety eyes between R 12 and R 13 at the distance of 7-8 st from each other.

R 15: (7 sc, inc)\*6 (54)

R 16: 54 sc

R 17: (7 sc, dec)\*6 (48)

R 18: (6 sc, dec)\*6 (42)

R 19: (5 sc, dec)\*6 (36)

R 20: (2 sc, dec)\*9 (27)

R 21: (1 sc, dec)\*9 (18)

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

### Ears (make 2)

With grey yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)\*6 (12)

R 3: (3 sc, inc)\*3 (15)

R 4: 15 sc

R 5: (4 sc, inc)\*3 (18)

R 6: 18 sc

R 7: (5 sc, inc)\*3 (21)

R 8: (6 sc, inc)\*3 (24)

R 9-13: 24 sc (5 rows)

R 14: (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

R 15: 18 sc

R 16: (4 sc, dec)\*3 (15)

R 17: 15 sc

Fold top of ear flat and 7 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Fold the ear edges together and sew them on the head.

### Legs and body

**Legs** (make 2)

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)\*6 (12)

R 3: (3 sc, 3 inc)\*2 (18)

R 4: BLO 18 sc

R 5: 18 sc

R 6: (1 sc, dec)\*6 (12)

Change to grey yarn:

R 7-10: 12 sc (4 rows)

R 11: (3 sc, inc)\*3 (15)

R 12-13: 15 sc (2 rows)

F.o.

Don't cut the yarn when you'll finish the second leg!

From the second leg: 3 ch, join with the first leg. Continue crocheting the *body* in the round: Stuff as you go.

R 1: 15 sc on the 1st leg, 3 sc in 3 ch, 15 sc on the 2nd leg, 3 sc in 3 ch (opposite side) (36)

R 2: (5 sc, inc)\*6 (42)

R 3-6: 42 sc (4 rows)

R 7: (12 sc, dec)\*3 (39)

Change to sweater color:

R 8: 39 sc

R 9: (11 sc, dec)\*3 (36)

R 10: 36 sc

R 11: (4 sc, dec)\*6 (30)

R 12-13: 30 sc (2 rows)

R 14: (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

R 15-16: 24 sc (2 rows)

R 17: (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

F.o.



### Tail

With grey yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (1 sc, inc)\*3 (9)

R 3: (1 sc, dec)\*3 (6)

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

### Arms (make 2)

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)\*6 (12)

R 3: 12 sc

R 4: (1 sc, dec)\*4 (8)

Change to grey yarn:

R 5: 8 sc

Change to sweater color:

R 6-15: 8 sc (10 rows)

Fold top of arm flat and 4 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.



### Snood

With sweater color:

Make 7 ch.

R 1: From the 3rd ch from hook: 5 hdc

Continue crocheting in turning rows:

R 2-17: 2 ch, from the 3rd ch from hook: BLO – 5 hdc

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

### Assembly

Sew the head to the body.

Sew the ears on the head.

Put the snood around the neck and sew the ends of the snood together.

Sew the tail and arms to the body.
