## **Materials:**

- Yarn: YamArt Jeans (green color #60, white #01, beige #05, brown #40 and grey #46)
- Hook size: 2.0-2.5 mm
- Black embroidery floss for eyes
- Grey embroidery floss for mouth
- Pink embroidery floss for cheeks
- Fiberfill

## **Abbreviations:**

- R = row
- mc = magic circle
- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- inc = 2 sc in the next stitch
- dec = single crochet 2 stitches together
- BLO = back loop only
- F.o. = finish off
- = 12 = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row
- ( ) \* 6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

# AMIGURUMI GNOME FREE PATTERN

## Head

With beige yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (inc)\* 6 = 12

R 3: (inc, 1 sc)\*6 = 18

R 4: (inc, 2 sc)\*6 = 24

R 5: (inc, 3 sc)\*6 = 30

R 6: (inc, 4 sc)\*6 = 36

R 7: (inc, 5 sc)\*6 = 42

R 8: (inc, 6 sc)\*6 = 48

R 9: (inc, 7 sc)\*6 = 54

R 10: 54 sc



R 11: (inc, 8 sc)\*6 = 60

R 12-18: 60 sc (7 rows)

R 19: (dec, 8 sc)\*6 = 54

R 20: (dec, 7 sc)\*6 = 48

R 21: (dec, 6 sc)\*6 = 42

R 22: (dec, 5 sc)\*6 = 36

R 23: (dec, 4 sc)\*6 = 30

R 24: (dec, 3 sc)\*6 = 24

R 25: (dec, 2 sc)\*6 = 18

R 26: (dec, 1 sc)\*6 = 12

R 27: (dec)\*6 = 6

F.o.

## Body

With green yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (inc)\*6 = 12

R 3: (inc, 1 sc)\*6 = 18

R 4: (inc, 2 sc)\*6 = 24

R 5: (inc, 3 sc)\*6 = 30

R 6: (inc, 4 sc)\*6 = 36

R 7: (inc, 5 sc)\*6 = 42

R 8: (inc, 6 sc)\*6 = 48

R 9: BLO 48 sc

R 10-11: 48 sc (2 rows)

R 12: with white yarn: 48 sc

R 13: (dec, 22 sc)\*2 = 46

R 14: (dec, 21 sc)\*2 = 44

R 15: with white yarn: (dec, 20 sc)\*2 = 42

R 16: (dec, 19 sc)\*2 = 40

R 17: (dec, 18 sc)\*2 = 38



R 18: with white yarn: (dec, 17 sc)\*2 = 36

R 19: (dec, 4 sc)\*6 = 30

R 20: 30 sc

R 21: with white yarn: (dec, 3 sc)\*6 = 24

R 22: 24 sc

R 23: (dec, 2 sc)\*6 = 18

R 24: 18 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

## Legs (make 2)

With brown yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (1 sc, inc)\*3 = 9

R 3: (2 sc, inc)\*3 = 12

R 4: 12 sc

R 5: (3 sc, inc)\*3 = 15

R 6-7: 15 sc (2 rows)

R 8: (3 sc, dec)\*3 = 12

R 9: 12 sc

R 10: (2 sc, dec)\*3 = 9

Fold top of leg flat and 4 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.





### Arms (make 2)

With beige yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (1 sc, inc)\*3 = 9

R 3: (2 sc, inc)\*3 = 12

R 4-5: 12 sc (2 rows)

Change to green yarn:

R 6: dec, 10 sc = 11

R 7: dec, 9 sc = 10

R 8: dec, 8 sc = 9

R 9-13: 9 sc (5 rows)

R 14: (dec, 1 sc)\*3 = 6

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.



### Nose

With pink yarn:

Make 4 ch.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 3 sc in one st, 1 sc, 3 sc in one st, 1 sc = 8

R 2: (3 inc, 1 sc)\*2 = 14

R 3: (1 sc, inc)\*3, 1 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*3, 1 sc = 20

R 4: 20 sc

R 5: (1 sc, dec)\*3, 1 sc, (1 sc, dec)\*3, 1 sc = 14

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.



### Ears (make 2)

With beige yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (inc)\*6 = 12

R 3: 12 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

### Hat

With red yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc = 6

R 2: (inc, 1 sc)\*3 = 9

R 3: (inc, 2 sc)\*3 = 12

R 4: (inc, 3 sc)\*3 = 15

R 5: (inc, 4 sc)\*3 = 18

R 6: (inc, 5 sc)\*3 = 21

R 7: (inc, 6 sc)\*3 = 24

R 8: (inc, 7 sc)\*3 = 27

R 9: (inc, 8 sc)\*3 = 30

R 10: (inc, 9 sc)\*3 = 33

R 11: inc, 32 sc = 34

R 12: inc, 33 sc = 35

R 13: inc, 34 sc = 36

R 14: inc, 35 sc = 37

R 15: inc, 36 sc = 38

R 16: inc, 37 sc = 39

R 17: inc, 38 sc = 40

R 18: inc, 39 sc = 41

R 19: inc, 40 sc = 42

R 20: (6 sc, inc)\*6 = 48

R 21: (7 sc, inc)\*6 = 54

R 22: (8 sc, inc)\*6 = 60

R 23: (1 sc, inc)\*30 = 90

R 24-26: 90 sc (3 rows)

R 27: (8 sc, inc)\*10 = 100

R 28-29: 100 sc (2 rows)

R 30: with grey yarn: crochet sc. Insert hook in R 29, then in R 28... Look at the picture.
