#### Materials:

 Yarn: YarnArt Jeans (55% cotton, 45% acrylic, 50 g/160 m)

· Hook size: 2.0 mm

· 6 mm safety eyes

Black embroidery floss

· Sewing needle and scissors

Fiberfill

#### Abbreviations:

R = row

mc = magic circle (magic ring)

ch = chain

st = stitch

sc = single crochet

inc = 2 sc in the next stitch

dec = single crochet 2 stitches together

F.o. = finish off

(12) = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

() \* 6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

## AMIGURUMI BAT FREE PATTERN

Arms (make 2)

R 1: 8 sc in mc (8)

R 2-7: 8 sc (6 rows)

Don't stuff with fiberfill.

Fold top of arm flat and 4 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Wings (make 2)

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc) \* 6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

R 6: (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

R 7: (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

Fold top of wing flat and make (6 sc, in increase sts of the previous row: 1 sc, 2 ch, 1 sc)\*3

F.o.

Ears (make 2)

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: 6 sc

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 3 (9)

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 3 (12)

R 5: 12 sc

R 6: (3 sc, inc) \* 3 (15)

R 7: 15 sc

R 8: (4 sc, inc) \* 3 (18)

R 9: (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

R 10-12: 24 sc (3 rows)

R 13: (6 sc, dec) \* 3 (21)

R 14: (5 sc, dec) \* 3 (18)

R 15: (4 sc, dec) \* 3 (15)

R 16-18: 15 sc (3 rows)

R 19: (3 sc, dec) \* 3 = 12

R 20: 12 sc

Fold top of ear flat and 6 sc through both sides

Fold top one time more and 3 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Head

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc) \* 6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30)

R 6-7: 30 sc (2 rows)

R 8: (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

R 9: 36 sc

R 10: (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42)

R 11: 42 sc

R 12: (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48)

R 13: 48 sc

R 14: (7 sc, inc) \* 6 (54)

R 15-20: 54 sc (6 rows)

Insert safety eyes between R 16 and R 17 at the distance of 10 sts from each other.

R 21: (7 sc, dec) \* 6 (48)

R 22: (6 sc, dec) \* 6 (42)

R 23: (5 sc, dec) \* 6 (36)

R 24: (4 sc, dec) \* 6 (30)

R 25: (3 sc, dec) \* 6 (24)

R 26: (2 sc, dec) \* 6 (18)

F.o.

Legs and Body (made as one piece)

Legs (make 2)

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (1 sc, inc) \* 3 (9)

R 3: 9 sc

R 4: (2 sc, inc) \* 3 (12)

R 5: 12 sc

R 6: (3 sc, inc) \* 3 (15)

R 7: 15 sc

F.o.

Don't cut the yarn when you'll finish the second leg! Join with the 1st leg.

Continue crocheting the **body** in the round:

R 8: 15 sc on the 1st leg, 15 sc on the 2nd leg (30)

R 9: 30 sc

R 10: (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (36)

R 11-14: 36 sc (4 rows)

R 15: (10 sc, dec) \* 3 = 33

R 16: (9 sc, dec) \* 3 = 30

R 17: (3 sc, dec) \* 6 = 24

R 18: (2 sc. dec) \* 6 = 18

R 19-20: 18 sc (2 rows)

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Assembly

Sew the head to the body.

Sew the ears on the sides of the head.

Sew the arms between R 18 and R 19 of the body.

Sew the wings on the back of the body.
