Abbreviations

AR – Amigurumi Magic ring
MR – Amigurumi Magic ring
App – application
ll – lift loop
sc : Single Crochet
inc : Increase
dec : Decrease
tr : Triple Crochet/ Treble Crochet
st: Stitch

dc : Double Crochet
hdc: Half Double Crochet
sl-st : Slip Stitch
ch : Chain
..in : make increase into same stitch as many as the number which is given in front of “inc” abbreviation (exp; 3inc, 4inc..).
FLO : Crochet into front loops only
BLO : Crochet into back loops only
BL : Bobble Stitch – do 5dc all in the same stitch and then yarn over and pull through all the loops on your hook (the original loop + 1 loop for each partially completed dc).

Head

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)
 Rnd 3) (1 sc, inc)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 4) (2 sc, inc)- 6 times (24)
 Rnd 5) (3 sc, inc)- 6 times (30)
 Rnd 6) (4 sc, inc)- 6 times (36)
 Rnd 7) (5 sc, inc)- 6 times (42)
 Rnd 8) (6 sc, inc)- 6 times (48)
 Rnd 9) (7 sc, inc)- 6 times (54)
 Rnd 10-19 (10 rnds) sc in each st around (54)
 Rnd 20) (7 sc, dec)- 6 times (48)
 Rnd 21) (6 sc, dec)- 6 times (42)
 Rnd 22) (5 sc, dec)- 6 times (36)
 Rnd 23) (4 sc, dec)- 6 times (30)
 Rnd 24) (3 sc, dec)- 6 times (24)
 Rnd 25) (2 sc, dec)- 6 times (18)

Body

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)
 Rnd 3) (1 sc, inc)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 4) (2 sc, inc)- 6 times (24)
 Rnd 5) (3 sc, inc)- 6 times (30)
 Rnd 6) (4 sc, inc)- 6 times (36)
 Rnd 7) (5 sc, inc)- 6 times (42)



Rnd 8-13 (6 rnds) sc in all sts around (42)
 Rnd 14) (5 sc, dec)- 6 times (36)
 Rnd 15) sc in all sts around (36)
 Rnd 16) (4 sc, dec)- 6 times (30)
 Rnd 17) Sc in all sts around (30)
 Rnd 18) (3 sc, dec)- 6 times (24)
 Rnd 19) sc in all sts around (24)
 Rnd 20) (2 sc, dec)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 21-22 (2 rnds) Sc in all sts around (18)

Arms

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) (inc)- 6 times (12)
 Rnd 3) (1 sc, inc)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 4) sc in each st around (18)
 Rnd 5) (1 sc, dec)- 6 times (12)
 Rnd 6) sc in each st around (12)
 Rnd 7) (2sc, dec)- 3 times (9)
 Rnd 8-19 (12 rnds) sc in each st around (9)



Foot and Leg

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) (inc)- 6 times (12)
 Rnd 3) (1 sc, inc)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 4) (2 sc, inc)- 6 times (24)
 Rnd 5) Sc in each st around (24)
 Rnd 6) (2 sc, dec)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 7) sc in each st around (18)
 Rnd 8) (1 sc, dec)- 6 times (12)
 Rnd 9) (2sc, dec)- 3 times (9)
 Rnd 10-23 (14 rnds) sc in each st around(9)



Eyes

White with yarn

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)
 Rnd 3) (1 sc, inc)- 6 times (18)
 Rnd 4-6 (3 rnds) sc in each st around(18)
 Rnd 7) (1 sc,dec)- 6 times (12)
 Rnd 8) 6 dec (6)

Black with yarn

Rnd 1) 6 sc in a MR (6)
 Rnd 2) 2sc in each st around (12)

Collar

Ch 2 and turn at the end of each row.

Row 1) ch 23, work 3 dc into the 4th st from your hook, (2 dc in the next st, 3 dc in the next st)- repeat until the end of the row (50)

Row 2) dc in each st across (50)
