## **Materials**

- 1) YarnArt Dolce 779 or Himalaya Dolphin 353 – 1.5 skeins.
- 2) YarnArt Dolce yarn in additional color (body) 759 or Himalaya Dolphin 314 – half winding.
- 3) Yarn Himalaya Dolphin in complementary color 310 (on stripes) – a little bit.
- 4) YarnArt Dolce color 769 (ears and nose) – a little.
- 5) Black iris – for embroidering the mouth.
- 6) Hook 4.5 mm.
- 7) Scissors.

- 8) Needle for stitching details and decoration faces.
- 9) Eyes 12 mm.
- 10) Filler (sintepuh, holofiber).

## **Abbreviations**

- MR: Magic ring  
Ch: Chain  
Sc: Single crochet  
Slst: Slip stitch  
Inc: Increase  
Dec: Decrease




## AMIGURUMI PIG FREE PATTERN

### Head

We crochet with YarnArt Dolce 779 or Himalaya Dolphin 353.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR;  
 Rnd 2. 6 inc (12);  
 Rnd 3. (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18);  
 Rnd 4. (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24);  
 Rnd 5. (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30);  
 Rnd 6. (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36);  
 Rnd 7. 36 sc;  
 Rnd 8. (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42);  
 Rnd 9- 12. 42 sc (4 row);



Starting from the next row, we begin tie cheeks.

Rnd 13. 6 sc, (inc, 1 sc) \* 2, 5 inc (cheek), (1sc, inc) \* 3 (place for a patch), 1 sc, 5 inc (cheek), (1sc, inc) \* 2, 11 sc (59);  
 Rnd 14. 6 sc, (2 sc, inc)\* 2, (1 sc, inc)\* 5 (cheek), (2sc, inc)\* 3, 1 sc, (1 sc, inc)\* 5 (cheek), (2 sc, inc)\* 2, 11 sc (76);

At this stage, the head will look like this.



Rnd 15. 76 sc;  
 Rnd 16. 6 sc, (2 sc, dec) \* 2, (1 sc, dec) \* 5 (cheek), (2 sc, dec) \* 3, 1 sc, (1 sc, dec) \* 5 (cheek), (2 sc, dec) \* 2, 11 sc (59);  
 Rnd 17. 59 sc;  
 Rnd 18. 10 sc, dec, 9 sc, dec, 7 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 13 sc, dec (54);  
 Rnd 19. 54 sc;  
 Rnd 20. (7 sc, dec) \* 6 (48);  
 Rnd 21. 48 sc;  
 Rnd 22. (6 sc, dec) \* 6 (42);  
 Rnd 23. 42 sc;  
 Rnd 24. (5 sc, dec) \* 6 (36);  
 Rnd 25. (4 sc, dec) \* 6 (30);  
 Rnd 26. (3 sc, dec) \* 6 (24);  
 Rnd 27. 24 sc, slst.



Leave the thread for sewing to the head.  
We insert the eyes between the 11th and 12th rows on distance 5-6 sc. We fill the head with filler.

### Ears (Make 2)

We crochet yarn YarnArt Dolce 769 color. filler we don't hit.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR

Rnd 2. 6 sc

Rnd 3. (1sc,inc)\*3 (9)

Rnd 4. (2sc,inc)\*3 (12)

Rnd 5. (3sc,inc)\*3 (15)

Rnd 6. (4sc,inc)\*3 (18)

Rnd 7. (5sc,inc)\*3 (21)

Rnd 8. (6sc,inc)\*3 (24)

Rnd 9. (7sc,inc)\*3 (27)

Rnd 10-12. 27 sc (3 row)

Rnd 13. (7sc,dec)\*3 (24)

Rnd 14. (6sc,dec)\*3 (21)

Rnd 15. (5sc,dec)\*3 (18)

Rnd 16. (4sc,dec)\*3 (15), slst.



Leave the thread for sewing the ear to the head.  
Ears sew between 3 and 6 rows of the head.



### Nose

We start crocheting with YarnArt Dolce 769 yarn.

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR

Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3. (3sc, 3 sc in 1 loop)\*3 (18)

Change the color of the yarn to the main one (color of the head)

Rnd 4-5. 18 sc, slst.

Leave the thread for sewing.



The nose is sewn between 12/13 and 17/18 rows.



### Mouth tightening

We retreat from the patch down 2 rows. Let's do 2 tightening in the corners of the mouth. Distance between straps 8 sc.



I also made a tightening between the eyes, but you can just place them closer initially. At me the distance is 6 sc. Can do 5 sc.



We embroider a mouth with a black iris in 2 additions.

## Body

We start crocheting the body with YarnArt Dolce 759 or Himalaya Dolphin 314.

We crochet stripes with Himalaya Dolphin 310 yarn.

- Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR;
- Rnd 2. 6 inc (12);
- Rnd 3. (1 sc, inc) \* 6 (18);
- Rnd 4. (2 sc, inc) \* 6 (24);
- Rnd 5. (3 sc, inc) \* 6 (30);
- Rnd 6. (4 sc, inc) \* 6 (36);
- Rnd 7. (5 sc, inc) \* 6 (42);
- Rnd 8. (6 sc, inc) \* 6 (48);
- Rnd 9. (7 sc, inc)\* 6 (54);
- Rnd 10. strip 310 color. 54 sc;
- Rnd 11- 14. 314 color. 54 sc (4 row);
- Rnd 15. strip 310 color. 54 sc;
- Rnd 16- 19. 314 color. 54 sc (4 row);
- Rnd 20. strip 310 color. 54 sc;
- Rnd 21- 22. 314 color. 54 sc (2 row);
- Rnd 23. (7 sc, dec)\* 2, 7 sc, dec, 1 sc, dec, (7 sc, dec) \* 2, 6 sc (48);
- Rnd 24. 48 sc;
- Rnd 25. strip 310 color. 48 sc;
- Rnd 26. 314 color. (6 sc, dec)\* 6 (42);
- Rnd 27. 42 sc;
- Rnd 28. (5 sc, dec)\* 6 (36);
- Rnd 29. 36 sc;
- Rnd 30. strip 310 color (4 sc, dec) \* 6 (30);
- Rnd 31. 314 color. 30 sc;
- Rnd 32. (3 sc, dec)\* 6 (24);
- Rnd 33. 24 sc, slst. We cut the thread.



The body is tightly stuffed with filler.

## Arms (Make 2)

We crochet with the main color.

- Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR
- Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)
- Rnd 3. (3sc,inc)\*3 (15)
- Rnd 4-19. 15 sc (16 row)
- Rnd 20. (3sc,dec)\*3 (12)
- Rnd 21. 12 sc
- Rnd 22. (2sc,dec)\*3 (9)
- Rnd 23. 9 sc



Fill the handles with filler at the bottom tightly, at the top less tight.

Fold the handle in half and crochet the walls together 5 sc. Leave the thread for sewing the handle to the body.

We sew the handles to the last row of the body.

## Legs (Make 2)

We crochet with yarn of the main color. We stuff tightly filler foot and then 1/3 legs. Top not stuffing.

We make 7 ch.

From 2 loops we crochet 5 sc, 3 sc in 1 loop, the second side of the chain – 4 sc, 1 inc (14).

Rnd 2. inc, 4 sc, 3 inc, 4 sc, 2 inc (20);

Rnd 3. 1 sc, inc, 4 sc, (1 sc, inc)\* 3, 4 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*2 (26);

Rnd 4. 2 sc, inc, 4 sc, (2 sc, inc)\* 3, 4 sc, (2 sc, inc)\*2 (32);

Rnd 5-7. 32 sc (3 row);

Rnd 8. 9 sc, 6 dec, 11 sc (26);

Rnd 9. 4 sc, dec, 3 sc, 3 dec, 3 sc, dec, 6 sc (21);

Rnd 10. 5 sc, 6 dec, 4 sc (15);

Rnd 11- 14. 15 sc;

Rnd 15. (3 sc, dec)\* 3 (12);

Rnd 16- 18. 12 sc (3 row);

Rnd 19. (2 sc, dec)\* 3 (9);

Rnd 20- 21. 9 sc (2 row);

Rnd 22. dec, 7 sc (8).



Fold the leg in half and connect the walls legs 4 sc. Leave the thread for sewing. Legs sew between 5 and 6 rows of the body.
