Materials:

- YarnArt Jeans yarn (yellow, white, pink and orange color)
- 2.0 mm crochet hook
- 5 mm safety eyes
- Sewing needle and scissors
- Fiberfill

Abbreviations:

R = row
mc = magic circle

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = 2 sc in the next stitch

dec = single crochet 2 stitches together

(12) = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row

(...)*6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

AMIGURUMI CHICK FREE PATTERN

Head and body

With yellow yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

R 6: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

R 7: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

R 8: (6 sc, inc)*6 (48)

R 9-13: 48 sc (5 rows)

Insert safety eyes between R 10 and R 11 at the distance of 3 st from each other.

R 14: (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)

R 15: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

R 16: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)

R 17: 30 sc

R 18: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

R 19: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

R 20: (6 sc, inc)*6 (48)

R 21: (7 sc, inc)*6 (54)

R 22-26: 54 sc (5 rows)

R 27: (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)

R 28: (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)

R 29: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

R 30: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)

R 31: (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)

R 32: (2 sc, dec)*6 (18)

R 33: (1 sc, dec)*6 (12)

R 34: (dec)*6 (6)

F.o.

Wings (make 2)

With yellow yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (1 sc, inc)*3 (9)

R 3: 9 sc

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*3 (12)

R 5-6: 12 sc (2 rows)

Fold top of wing flat and 6 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Belly

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24), sl st

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Feet (make 2)

With orange yarn:

Make 7 ch, work on both sides of the chain.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 3 sl st, 4 ch, 3 sl st, 4 ch, turn and crochet on the opposite side of the chain: 3 sl st, 4 ch, 3 sl st

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Headband

With white yarn:

Make 24 ch.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 23 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Bunny ears (make 2)

With pink yarn:

Make 6 ch.

Make an oval starting from the 2nd ch from hook, work on both sides of the chain.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 2 sc, 2 hdc, 5 dc in last st, turn and crochet on the opposite side of the chain: 2 hdc, 2 sc (13)

Change to white yarn:

R 2: inc, 3 sc, 5 inc, 3 sc, inc (20)

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Bunny tail

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: 12 sc

R 4: (dec)*6 (6)

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Embroider a beak with orange yarn.

Embroider cheeks with pink yarn.

Embroider whites of the eyes with white yarn.
