Materials

- Thread; white, pink, light blue, red
- Fiber for filling
- Plastic eye accessory
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- sc– single crochet
- inc– increase
- dec– decrease
- MR– magic ring
- BLO– Back loop only
- st(s) – stitch(es)
- ch– chain

AMIGURUMI COW FREE PATTERN

Head

Use white yarn

Rnd 1. 8 sc in MR (8)

Rnd 2. 8 inc (16)

Rnd 3. White: (1sc, 1inc) * 5, pink: (1sc, 1inc) * 2, white (1sc, 1inc) (24)

Rnd 4. White: (1sc, 1inc, 1sc) * 5, 1sc, Pink: 1inc, 2sc, 1inc, white: 2sc, 1inc, 1sc (32)

Rnd 5. White: (3sc, 1inc) * 5, Pink: 3sc, 1inc, 3sc, 1inc, white: 3sc, 1inc (40)

Rnd 6. White: 25 sc, pink: 10 sc, white: 5 sc (40)

Rnd 7. White: 26sc, pink: 8sc, white: 6sc (40)

Rnd 8. (1sc, 1inc, 3sc)*5, 1sc, 1inc, pink: 4sc, 1inc, white: 4sc, 1inc, 3sc (48)

Rnd 9-12. White: 34sc, pink: 4sc, white: 10sc (48)

Rnd 13. White: 12 sc, (1sc, 1inc) * 12, 12sc (60)

Rnd 14. White: 14 sc, Pink: 2sc, White: 44 sc (60)

Rnd 15. White: 13 sc, Pink: 4 sc, White: 43sc (60)

Rnd 16. White: 12 sc, Pink: 6 sc, White: 42 sc (60)

Rnd 17. White: 12 sc, Pink: 6 sc, White: 42 sc (60)

Rnd 18. White: 13 sc, Pink: 1 dec, 1sc, 1dec, White: (1sc, 1dec) * 10, 12sc (48)

From here, you'll use white yarn

Rnd 19. 48 sc (48)

Rnd 20. (2sc, 1dec, 2sc) * 8 (40)

Rnd 21. (3sc, 1dec) * 8 (32)

Rnd 22. (1sc, 1dec, 1sc) * 8 (24)

Cut the thread leaving enough length for sewing. Stuff with the fiberfill. Make eyes socket, place the safety eyes between rounds 12 and 13 at about 10 sts apart.

Horn

Use pink yarn

Rnd 1. 4sc in MR (4)

Rnd 2. (1sc, 1inc) * 2 (6)

Rnd 3. (1sc, 1inc) * 3 (9)

Cut and secure the yarn. Sew the horn to the head.

Ear

Use light pink yarn

Rnd 1. 4sc in MR (4)

Rnd 2. (1sc, 1inc) * 2 (6)

Rnd 3. 6inc (12)

Rnd 4. (3sc, 1inc) * 3 (15)

Rnd 5-6. 15sc (15)

Rnd 7. (3sc, 1dec) * 3 (12)

Cut the yarn. Sew the ear to the head.

Muzzle

Use pink yarn

Rnd 1. Chain 5, start from the second st from the hook, 1inc, 3sc, 4sc in the last st, 3sc, 1inc

Rnd 2. 2inc, 3sc, 4inc, 3sc, 2inc (22)

Rnd 3. BLO, 22 sc (22)

Cut the yarn. Sew the muzzle to the head.

Bow

Use blue yarn

Chain 11

Rnd 1. Starting in second ch from hook, 10 sc, turn back (10 sts).

Rnd 2-4. ch1, 10 sc, turn back (10 sts).

Fasten off and leave long end for sewing. Wrap the middle of the bow with a yarn a couple of times.

Sew the bow to the head.

Leg

Use pink yarn

Rnd 1. 6 sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3. BLO, 12 sc (12)

Change to white yarn

Rnd 4-6. 12 sc (12)

Cut and secure the yarn.

Make the other leg but don't cut the thread and continue working the body.

Body

Rnd 1. 12 sc of the second leg, chain 6 and join with the first leg, 12sc of the first leg, 6 sc in 6ch, place a stitch marker in the last sts (36)

Rnd 2. 36 sc (36)

Rnd 3. (5sc, 1inc) * 6 (42)

Rnd 4. 42 sc (42)

Rnd 5. (6sc, 1inc) * 6 (48)

Rnd 6. white: 8sc, pink: 3sc, white: 37 sc (48)

Rnd 7. white: 7sc, pink: 5sc, white: 36 sc (48)

Rnd 8. white: 6sc, pink: 7sc, white: 35 sc (48)

Rnd 9-10. white: 5sc, pink: 9sc, white: 34 sc (48)

Rnd 11. white: 6sc, pink : 1dec, 5sc, white: 1sc, 1dec, (6sc, 1dec) * 4 (42)

Rnd 12. white: 7sc, pink: 4sc; white : 31 sc (42)

Rnd 13. white: 5sc, 1dec, 1sc, pink: 2sc, white: 2sc, 1dec, (5sc, 1dec) * 4 (36)

Rnd 14-15. 36 sc (36)

Rnd 16. (2sc, 1dec, 2sc) * 6 (30)

Rnd 17. (3sc, 1dec) * 6 (24)

Cut and secure the thread. Stuff the body. Sew the body to the head.

Arm

Use pink yarn

Rnd 1. 6sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2. (1sc, 1inc) * 3 (9)

Rnd 3. 9 sc (9)

Change to white yarn

Rnd 4-12. 9sc (9)

Cut and secure the yarn. Sew the arm to the body.

Necklace

Use blue yarn, chain 40.

Cut and secure the yarn. Sew the bell to the middle of the necklace. Sew the necklace to the cow.

Bag

Use red yarn

Rnd 1. 6sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2. 6inc (12)

Rnd 3. (1sc, 1inc) * 6 (18)

Rnd 4-5. 18sc (18)

Rnd 6. (1sc, 1dec) * 6 (12)

Rnd 7. (3sc in same st)* 12

Cut and secure the yarn.

Use yellow yarn to decor the bag.

Use red yarn, chain 50, cut and secure the yarn.

Sew the chain to 2 side of the bag.
