You can learn how to crochet these fox using the free amigurumi pattern. The amigurumi fox is 13 cm (5") tall when crocheted with YarnArt Jeans yarn and a 2.25 mm Clover crochet hook. Materials:

- Yarn: YarnArt Jeans (55% cotton, 45% acrylic, 50 g/160 m)
- Hook size: 2.25 mm Clover crochet hook (or a normal crochet hook size 2.0 mm)
- 8 mm safety eyes
- Black embroidery floss for eyebrows and eyelashes
- Sewing needle and scissors
- Sewing pins
- Fiberfill

Abbreviations:

- R = row
- mc = magic circle
- ch = chain
- st = stitch
- sc = single crochet
- inc = 2 sc in the next stitch
- dec = single crochet 2 stitches together
- F.o. = finish off
- () = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row
- () * 7 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated



AMIGURUMI FOX FREE PATTERN

Head

With orange yarn:

- R 1: 7 sc in mc (7)
- R 2: (inc) * 7 = (14)
- R 3: (1 sc, inc) * 7 (21)
- R 4: (2 sc, inc) * 7 (28)
- R 5: (3 sc, inc) * 7 (35)
- R 6: (4 sc, inc) * 7 (42)
- R 7: (5 sc, inc) * 7 (49)
- R 8-18: 49 sc (11 rows)

Insert safety eyes between R 14 and R 15 at the distance of 7 st from each other.

- R 19: (5 sc, dec) * 7 (42)
 - R 20: (4 sc, dec) * 7 (35)
 - R 21: (3 sc, dec) * 7 (28)
 - R 22: (2 sc, dec) * 7 (21)
 - R 23: (5 sc, dec) * 3 (18)
- F.o.

Arms (make 2)

With orange yarn:

- R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)
- R 2: (inc) * 6 (12)
- R 3: 12 sc

Change to sweater color:

- R 4: 12 sc

R 5: 2 dec, 8 sc (10)

R 6-14: 10 sc (9 rows)

Stuff ½ full.

Fold top of the arm and 4 sc through both sides across.

F.o.

Tail

With white yarn:

- R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)
- R 2: (1 sc, inc) * 3 (9)
- R 3: (2 sc, inc) * 3 (12)
- R 4: (3 sc, inc) * 3 (15)
- R 5: (4 sc, inc) * 3 (18)

Change to orange yarn:

- R 6-9: 18 sc (4 rows)
 - R 10: (4 sc, dec) * 3 (15)
 - R 11: 15 sc
 - R 12: (3 sc, dec) * 3 (12)
 - R 13-15: 12 sc (3 rows)
- Stuff with fiberfill.

Fold top of tail flat and 5 sc through both sides across.

F.o.

Attach the tail to the body with single crochet on R 5 as you crochet the body.

Legs and Body

Legs (make 2)

With orange yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc) * 6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc) * 3, 6 sc (15)

R 4-7: 15 sc (4 rows)

F. o.

Don't cut the yarn when you'll finish the second leg!

From the second leg: 4 ch, join with the first leg (38)

Continue crocheting the **body** in the round:

R 1: 4 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 10 sc (42)

R 2-3: 42 sc (2 rows)

Change to sweater color:

R 4-7: 42 sc (4 rows)

R 8: (5 sc, dec) * 6 (36)

R 9: 36 sc

Stuff with fiberfill.

R 10: (4 sc, dec) * 6 (30)

R 11-12: 30 sc (2 rows)

R 13: (3 sc, dec) * 6 (24)

R 14: 24 sc

R 15: (2 sc, dec) * 6 (18)

R 16: Attach arms on the sides of the body (crochet sc of the body together with sc of the arm) – 18 sc

R 17: 18 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Ears (make 2)

With orange yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (1 sc, inc) * 3 (9)

R 3: (2 sc, inc) * 3 (12)

R 4: (3 sc, inc) * 3 (15)

R 5: (4 sc, inc) * 3 (18)

Fold top of the ear and 8 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Muzzle

With white yarn:

R 1: 8 sc in mc (8)

R 2: (1 sc, inc) * 4 (12)

R 3: (2 sc, inc) * 4 (16)

R 4: (3 sc, inc) * 4 (20)

R 5: 20 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Pin the muzzle to the head and sew on. Put some stuffing inside the muzzle before you finish.

Embroider a nose with black yarn.

Embroider eyebrows and lashes with black floss.

Embroider ticks on the head with white yarn.
