Materials:

- Yarn: Pekhorka Successful (100% cotton, 50 g/220 m)
- Hook: 1.75 mm
- Black safety eyes
- One wooden button
- Sewing needle and scissors
- Fiberfill

Abbreviations:

R = row
mc = magic circle
ch = chain

sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
inc = 2 sc in the next stitch
dec = single crochet 2 stitches together
BLO = back loop only
FLO = front loop only
F.o. = fasten off
(12) = number of stitches you should have at the end of the round/row
(...)*6 = repeat whatever is between the brackets the number of times stated

AMIGURUMI RACCOON FREE PATTERN

Legs and body are crocheted as a single part.

Legs (make 2)

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

R 6: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

R 7: BLO 36 sc

R 8: 36 sc

R 9: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)

R 10: 30 sc

R 11: (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)

R 12: 24 sc

Stuff with fiberfill.

R 13: 24 sc

Change to grey yarn:

R 14-21: 24 sc (8 rows)

F.o.

Don't cut the yarn when you will finish the second leg!

From second leg: 3 ch, join with the first leg.

Continue crocheting the body in the round:

Body

With grey yarn:

R 1: 24 sc on the first leg, 3 sc in 3 ch, 24 sc on the second leg, 3 sc in 3 ch (opposite side) (54)

R 2: 54 sc

R 3: 10 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 10 sc, inc, 2 sc (60)

R 4-5: 60 sc (2 rows)

R 6: (9 sc, inc)*6 (66)

R 7-8: 66 sc (2 rows)

Change to pink yarn:

R 9: BLO 66 sc

R 10-11: 66 sc (2 rows)

R 12: (9 sc, dec)*6 (60)

R 13: 60 sc

R 14: (8 sc, dec)*6 (54)

R 15-18: 54 sc (4 rows)

R 19: (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)

R 20-21: 48 sc (2 rows)

R 22: (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)

R 23-24: 42 sc (2 rows)

R 25: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

R 26: 36 sc

R 27: BLO 36 sc

Collar

Turn work.

R 1: 2 ch, FLO dc in every st to the end of R 27

R 2: dc in every st to the end of row

F.o.

Go to the R 9 of the body, join pink yarn and crochet FLO sc in every st to the end of row.

Arms (make 2)

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

R 5-6: 24 sc (2 rows)

R 7: (7 sc, dec)*3 (21)

R 8: (1 sc, dec)*7 (14)

Stuff with fiberfill

Change to pink yarn:

R 9: BLO 14 sc

R 10-24: 14 sc (15 rows)

Fold top of arm flat and 7 sc through both sides across.

Go to the R 9, join pink yarn and crochet FLO sc in every st to the end of row.

Head

With grey yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)

R 2: (inc)*6 (12)

R 3: (1 sc, inc)*6 (18)

R 4: (2 sc, inc)*6 (24)

R 5: (3 sc, inc)*6 (30)

R 6: (4 sc, inc)*6 (36)

R 7: (5 sc, inc)*6 (42)

R 8: (6 sc, inc)*6 (48)

R 9: (7 sc, inc)*6 (54)

R 10: (8 sc, inc)*6 (60)

R 11: (9 sc, inc)*6 (66)

R 12: (10 sc, inc)*6 (72)

R 13: (11 sc, inc)*6 (78)

R 14: (12 sc, inc)*6 (84)

R 15-28: 84 sc (14 rows)

R 29: (12 sc, dec)*6 (78)

R 30: (11 sc, dec)*6 (72)

R 31: (10 sc, dec)*6 (66)
 R 32: (9 sc, dec)*6 (60)
 R 33: (8 sc, dec)*6 (54)
 R 34: (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)
 R 35: (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)
 R 36: (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)
 R 37: (4 sc, dec)*6 (30)
 F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.



Eye spots (make 2)

With black yarn:
 Crochet in turning rows.
 Make 17 ch.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 16 sc, turn
 R 2: 16 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 3: 16 sc, turn
 R 4: 15 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 5: 15 sc, turn
 R 6: 14 sc, turn
 R 7: 13 sc, turn
 R 8: 12 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 9: 12 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 10: 12 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 11: 12 sc, turn
 R 12: 11 sc, turn
 R 13: 10 sc, turn
 R 14: 9 sc, turn
 R 15: 8 sc, turn
 R 16: 7 sc + 1 ch, turn
 R 17: 7 sc, turn
 R 18: 6 sc, turn
 R 19: 4 sc, turn
 R 20: 3 sc, turn
 R 21: 2 sc, turn
 R 22: 1 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

With white yarn: sc around two edges of eye spot.

Sew eye spots to the head.

Insert safety eyes between R 23 and R 24 of the head at the distance of 12-13 st from each other. Embroider eye whites with white yarn.

Tail

With white yarn:

R 1: 6 sc in mc (6)
 R 2: (1 sc, inc)*3 (9)
 R 3: 9 sc
 R 4: (2 sc, inc)*3 (12)
 R 5: (3 sc, inc)*3 (15)
 R 6: (4 sc, inc)*3 (18)
 R 7: (5 sc, inc)*3 (21)
 R 8: 21 sc

Change to grey yarn:

R 9-10: 21 sc (2 rows)

Change to black yarn:

R 11-12: 21 sc (2 rows)

Change to grey yarn:

R 13: (5 sc, dec)*3 (18)

R 14: 18 sc

With black yarn:

R 15-16: 18 sc (2 rows)

Change to grey yarn:

R 17: (4 sc, dec)*3 (15)

R 18: 15 sc

Change to black yarn:

R 19: (3 sc, dec)*3 (12)

R 20: 12 sc

Change to grey yarn:

R 21-24: 12 sc (4 rows)

Stuff with fiberfill.

Fold top of tail flat and 6 sc through both sides across.

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Muzzle

With white yarn:

R 1: 7 sc in mc (7)
 R 2: (inc)*7 (14)
 R 3: 14 sc
 R 4: (2 sc, inc)*4, 2 sc (18)
 R 5: 18 sc
 R 6: (3 sc, inc)*4, 2 sc (22)
 R 7: 22 sc

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

Ears (make 2)

With grey yarn:

Crochet in turning rows.

Make 13 ch.

R 1: From the 2nd ch from hook: 12 sc, turn

R 2: 11 sc, turn

R 3: 10 sc, turn

R 4: 9 sc, turn

R 5: 8 sc, turn

R 6: 7 sc, turn

R 7: 6 sc, turn

R 8: 5 sc, turn

R 9: 4 sc, turn

R 10: 3 sc, turn

R 11: 2 sc, turn

F.o. and leave a long tail for sewing.

With black yarn: sc around two edges of ear.

Pinup headband

With pink yarn:

Make 98 ch + 1 ch.

9 ch (1st leaf) + 80 ch (headband) + 9 ch (2nd leaf)

1st leaf: From the 2nd ch from hook: sc, hdc, dc, tr, (2 tr in one st)*3, dc, 2 dc in one st.

80 sc in 80 ch.

2nd leaf: 2 dc in one st, tr, (2 tr in one st)*3, tr, dc, hdc, 3 sc in last st.

Turn work.

2nd leaf: sc, hdc, dc, tr, (2 tr in one st)*3, tr, 2 dc in one st.

80 sc in 80 ch (opposite side).

1st leaf: 2 dc in one st, tr, (2 tr in one st)*3, tr, dc, hdc, 2 dc in one st, sl st.
